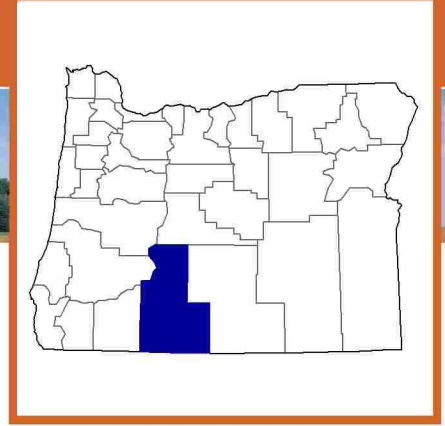

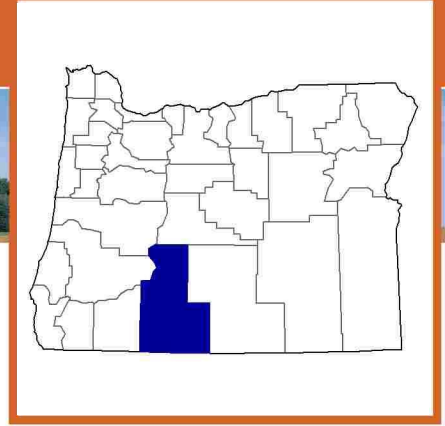


## Klamath County, Oregon Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

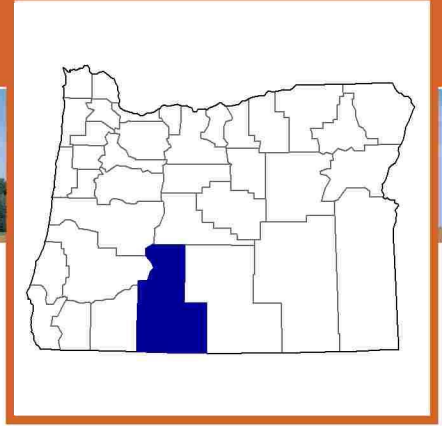


## Klamath County, Oregon Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

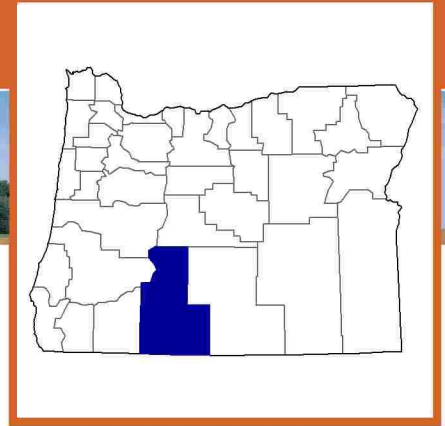

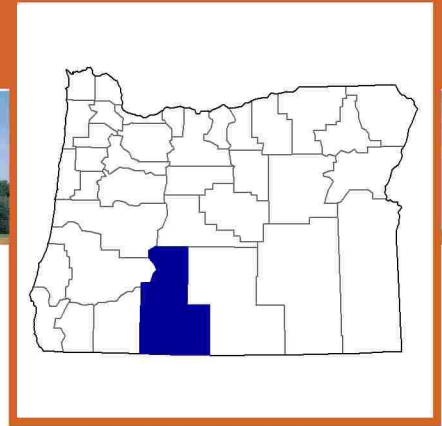

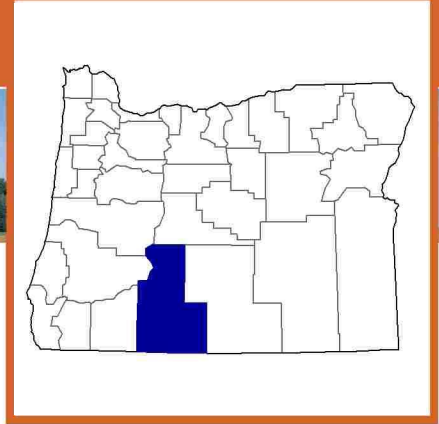
