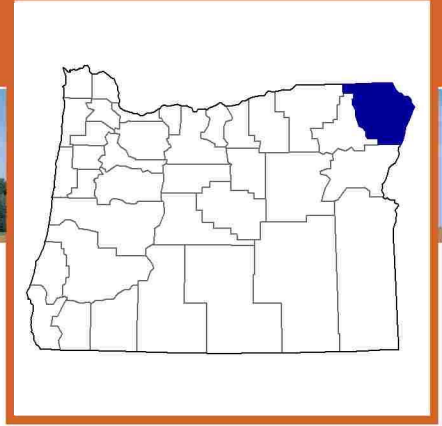


## Wallowa County, Oregon Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

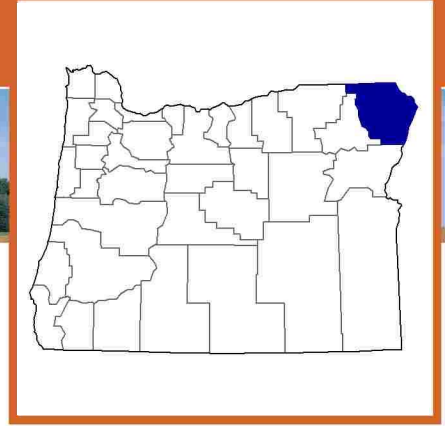


## Wallowa County, Oregon Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

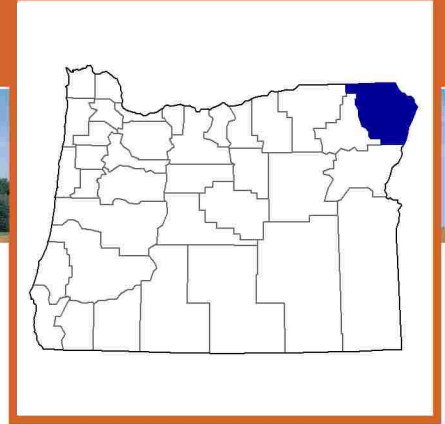

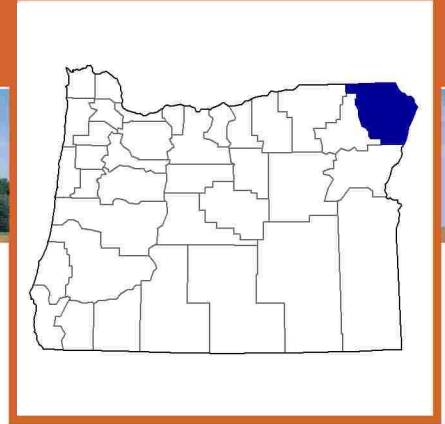

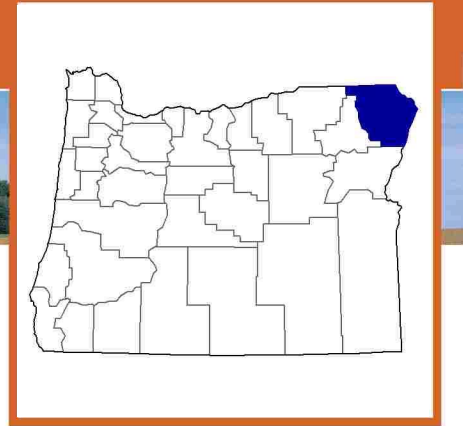
