

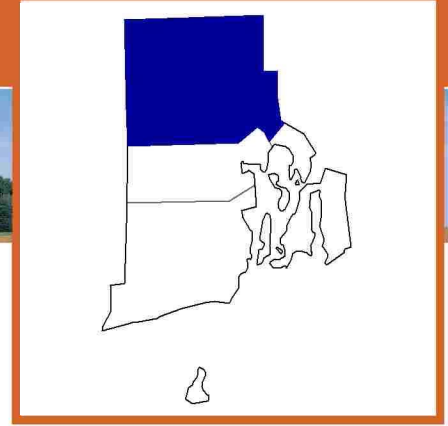

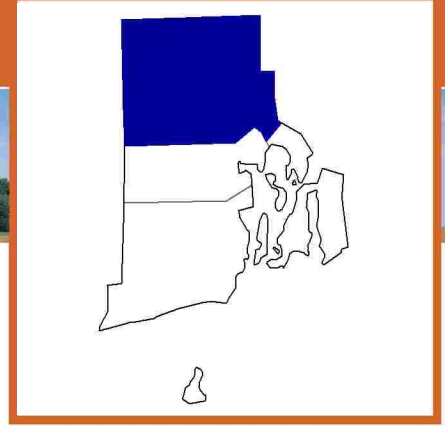


Providence County, Rhode Island Farms with Asian Producers^a

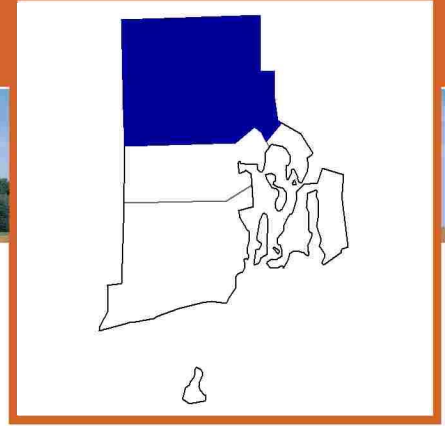

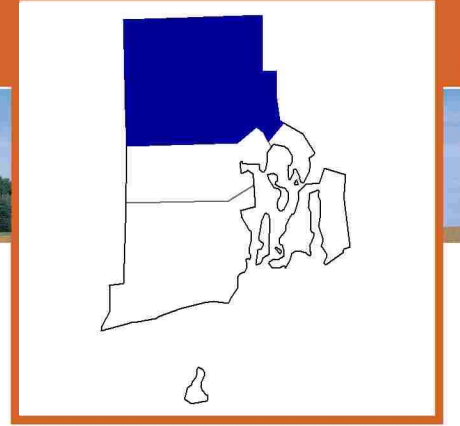

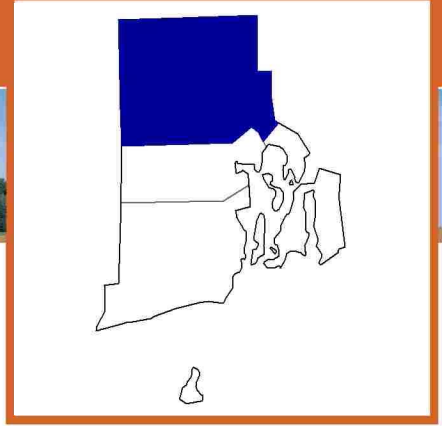


Providence County, Rhode Island Farms with White Producers^a



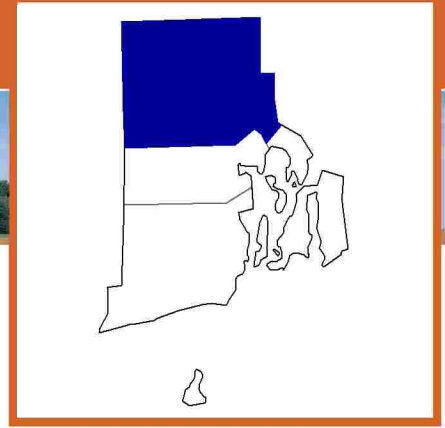
