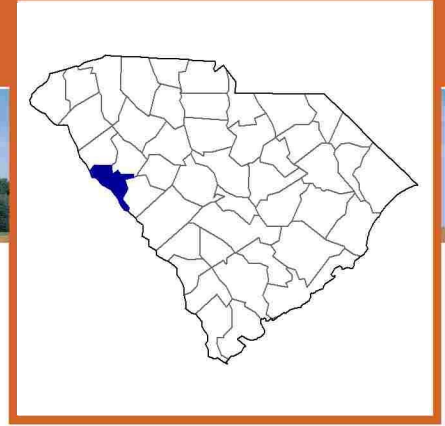

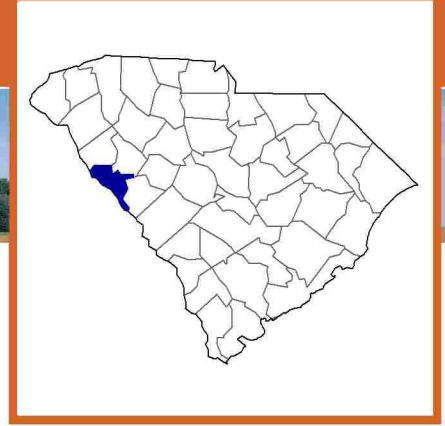


## McCormick County, South Carolina Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

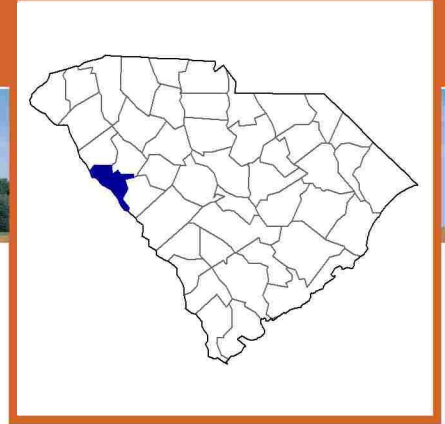


## McCormick County, South Carolina Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

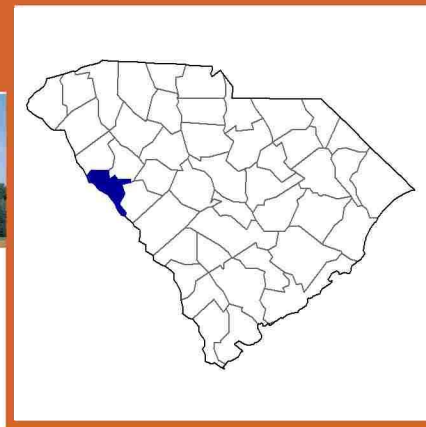

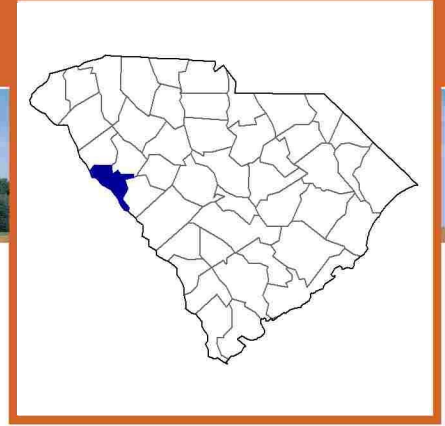

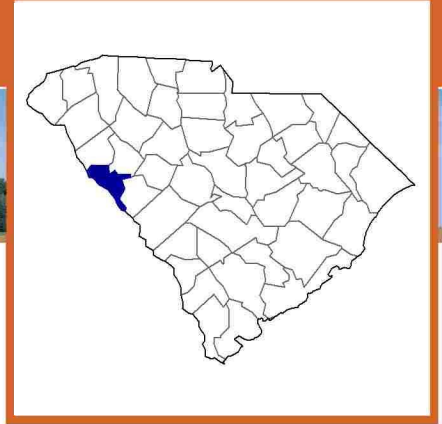
