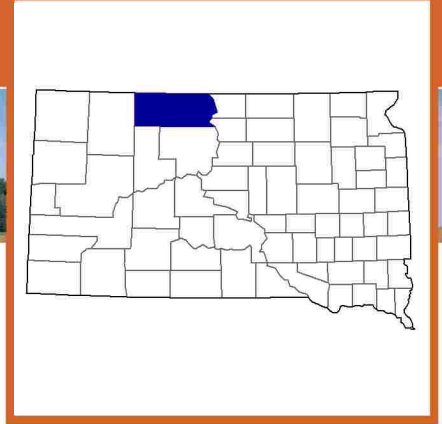


Corson County, South Dakota Farms with Asian Producers^a

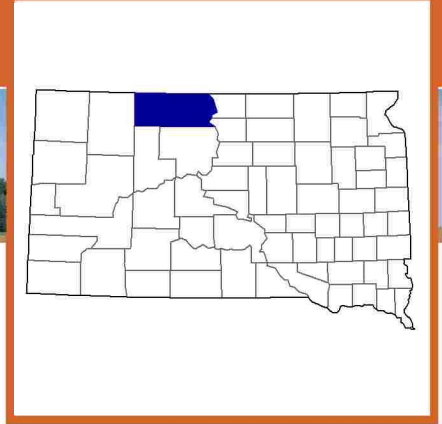

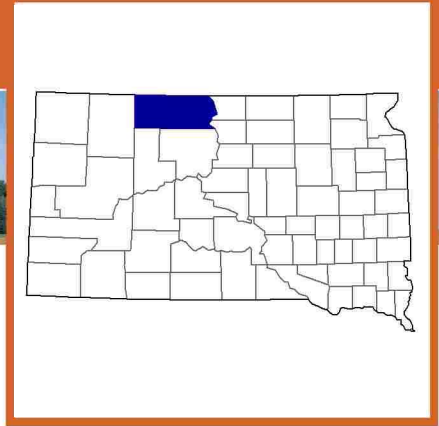
