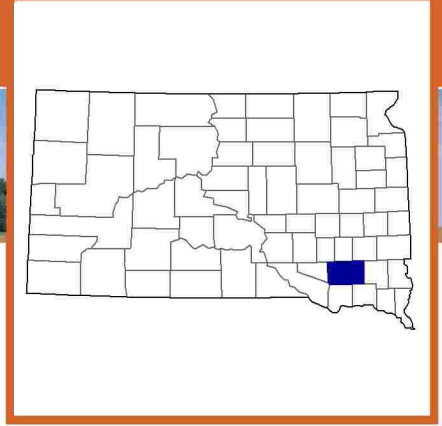


## Hutchinson County, South Dakota Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

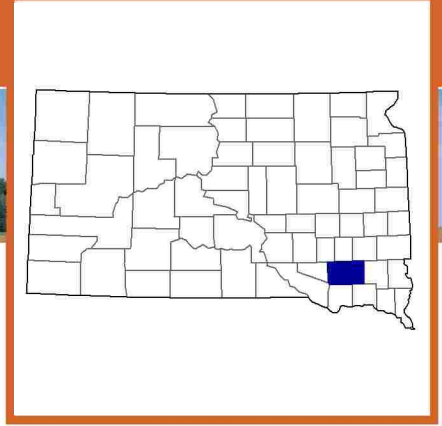


## Hutchinson County, South Dakota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

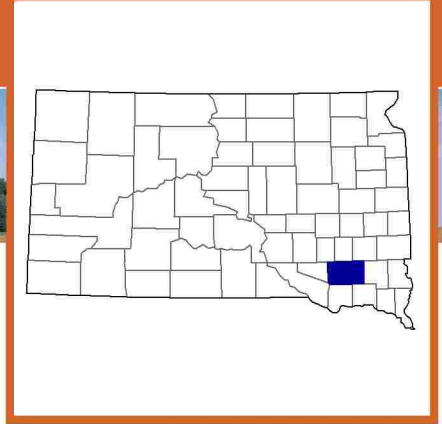


## Hutchinson County, South Dakota Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

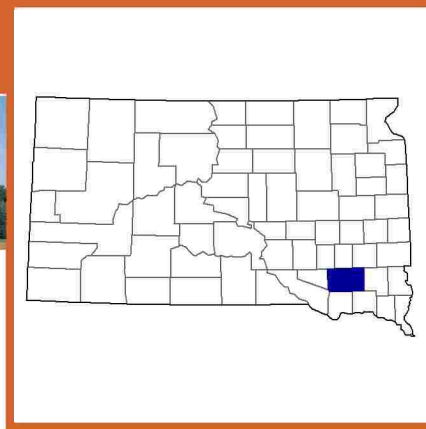

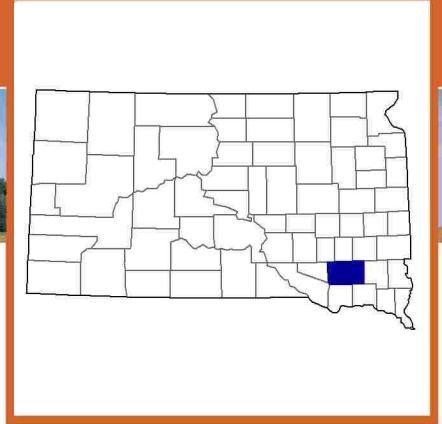

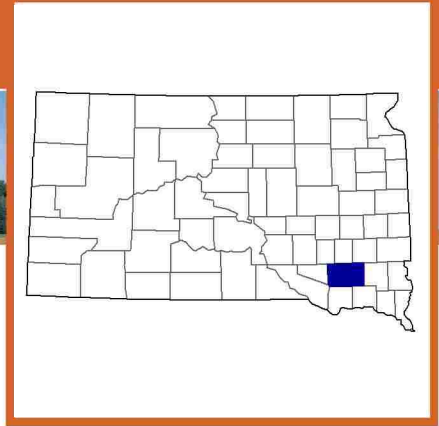
