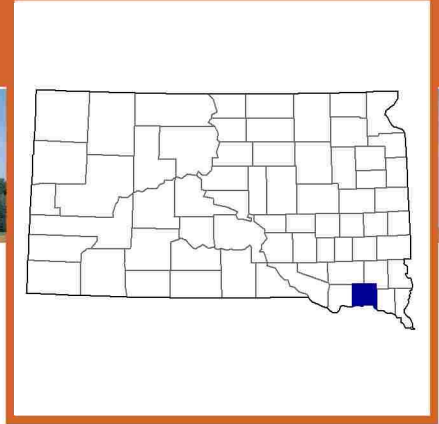


Yankton County, South Dakota Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

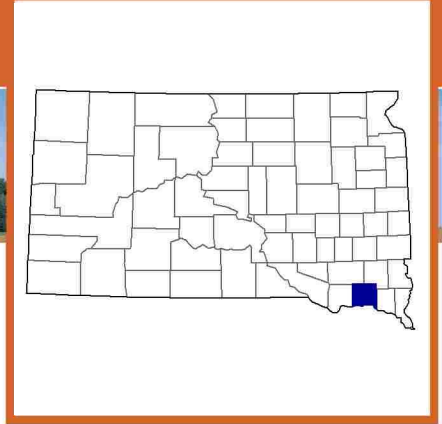

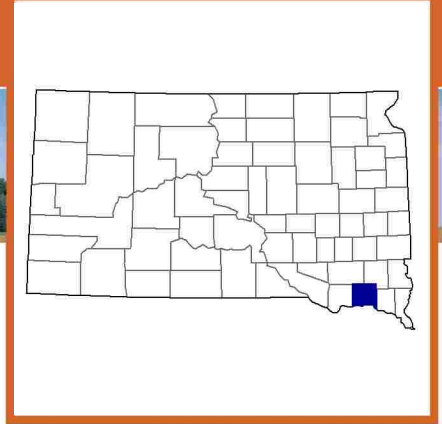

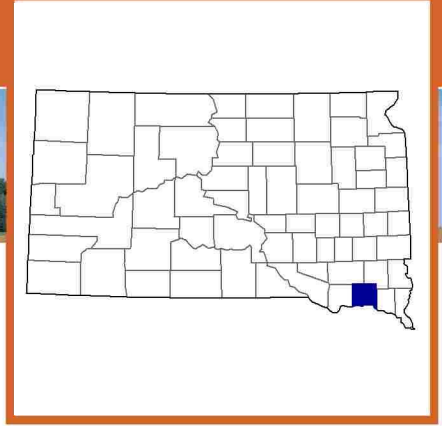

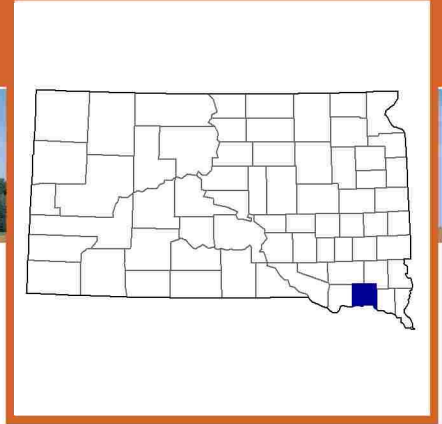

Yankton County, South Dakota Farms with White Producers^a

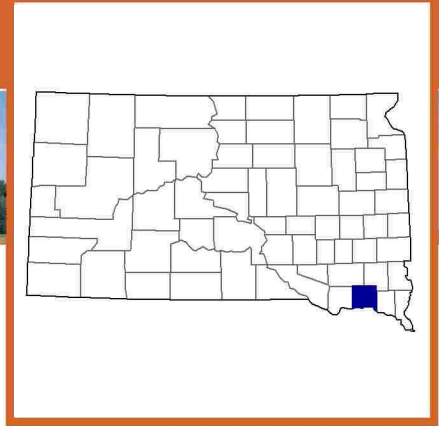
