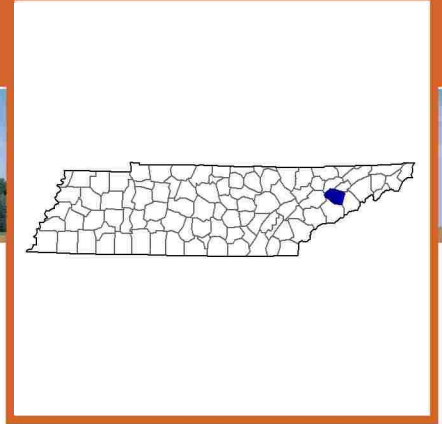


## Jefferson County, Tennessee Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

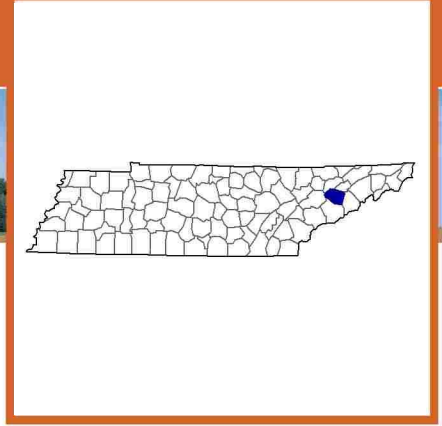


## Jefferson County, Tennessee Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

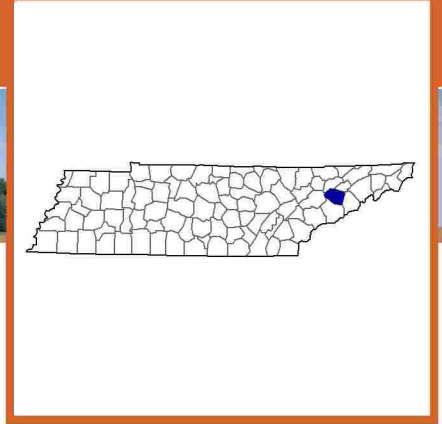


## Jefferson County, Tennessee Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

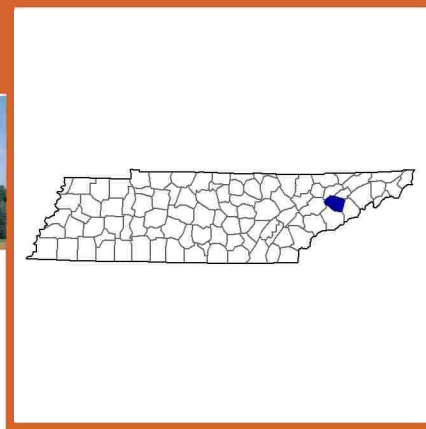

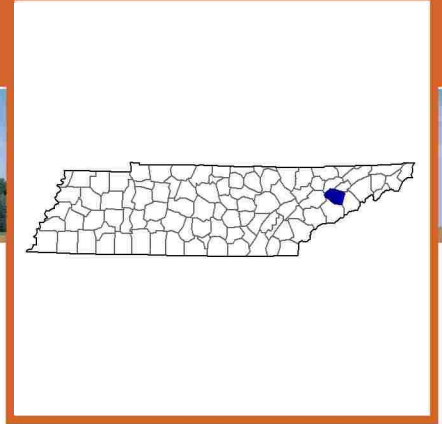

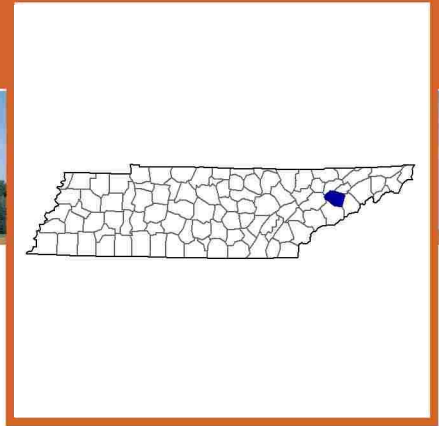
