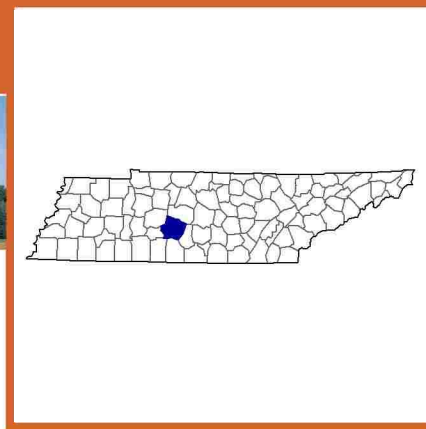


## Maury County, Tennessee Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

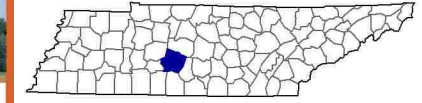

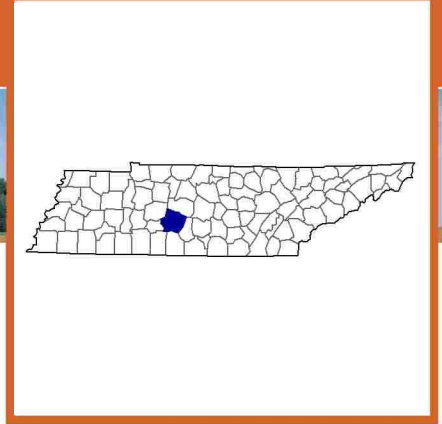

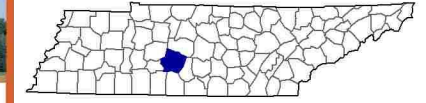

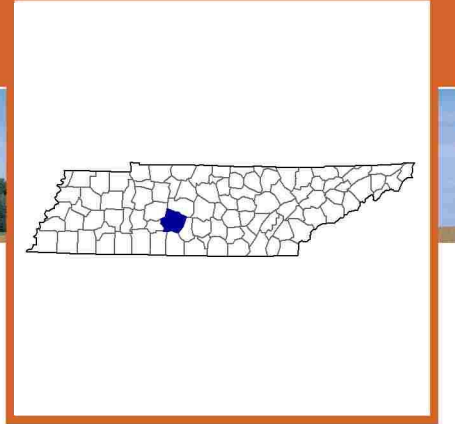
