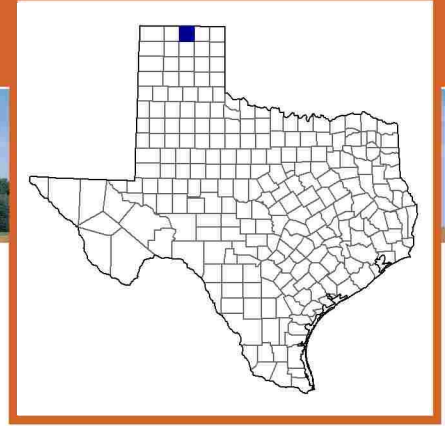


## Hansford County, Texas Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

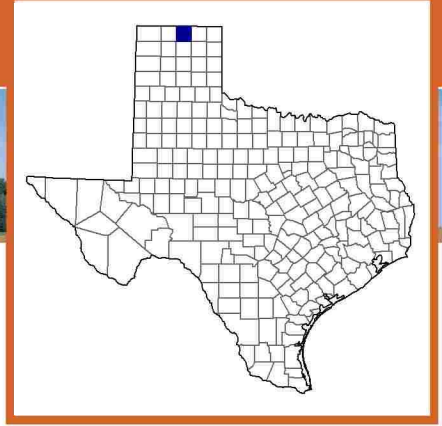


## Hansford County, Texas Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

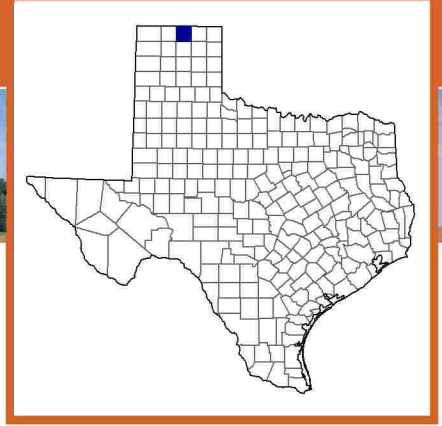


## Hansford County, Texas Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

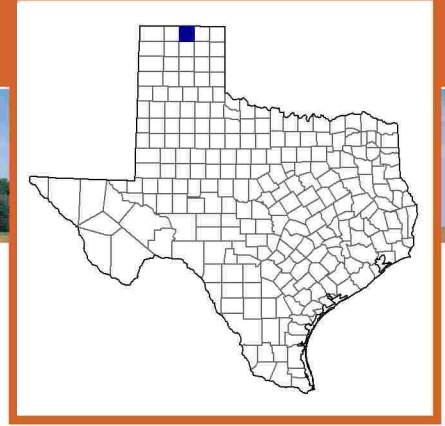

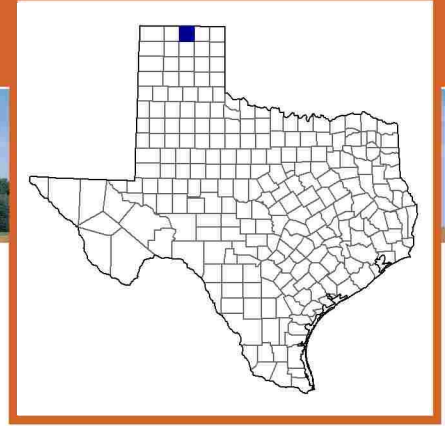

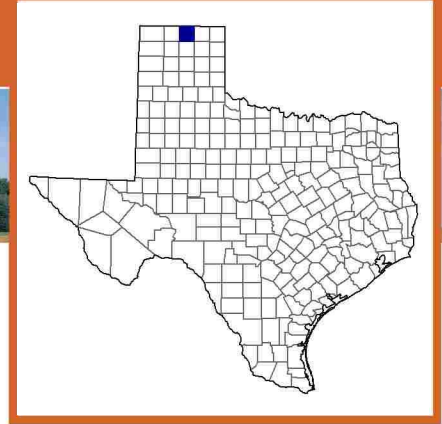
