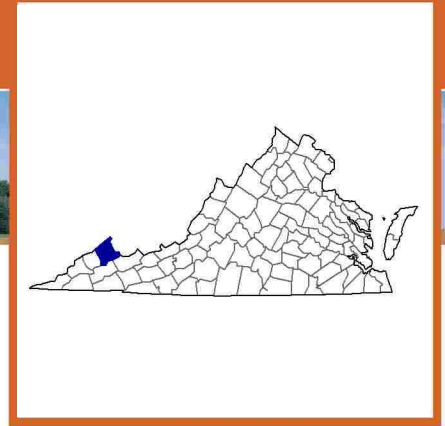

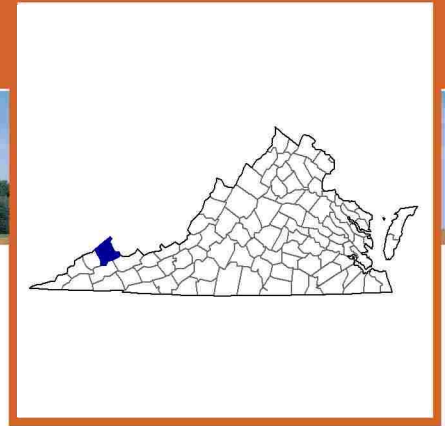


## Buchanan County, Virginia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

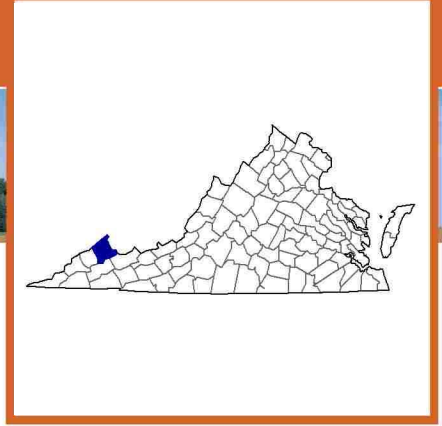


## Buchanan County, Virginia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

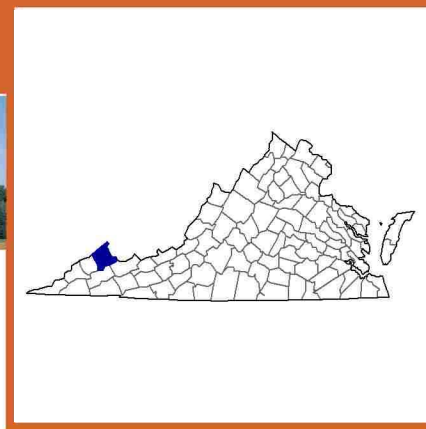

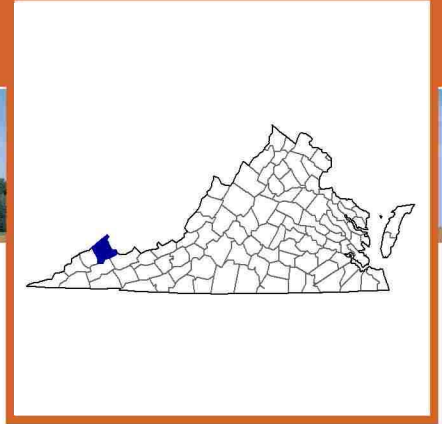
