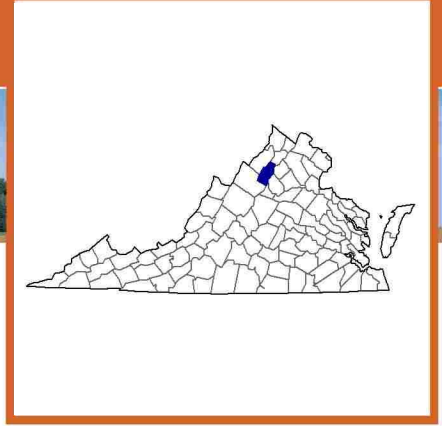


## Page County, Virginia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

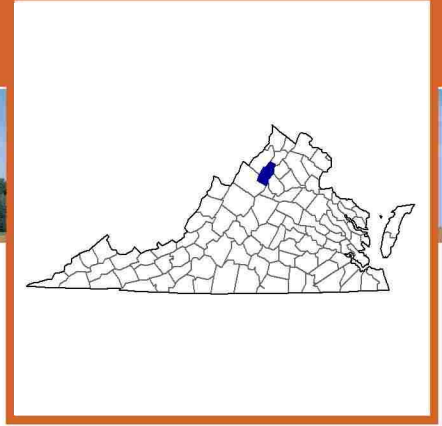


## Page County, Virginia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

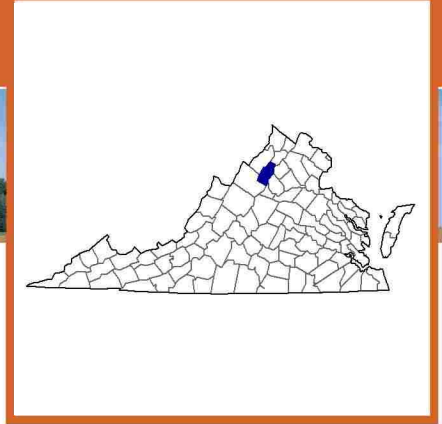

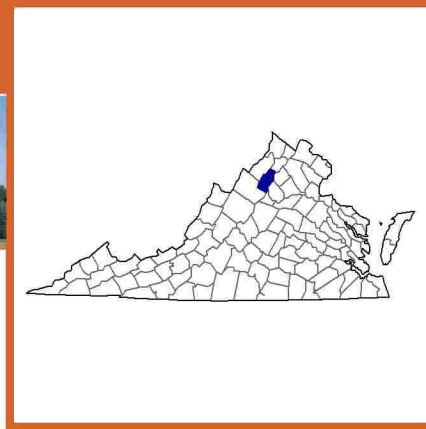

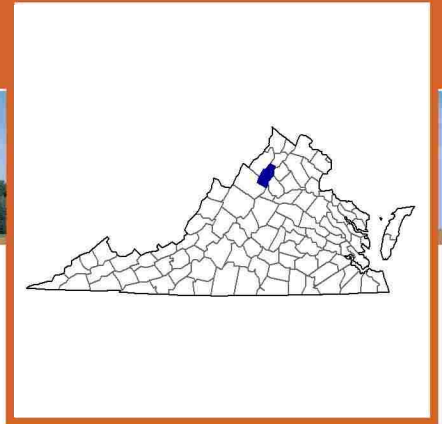
