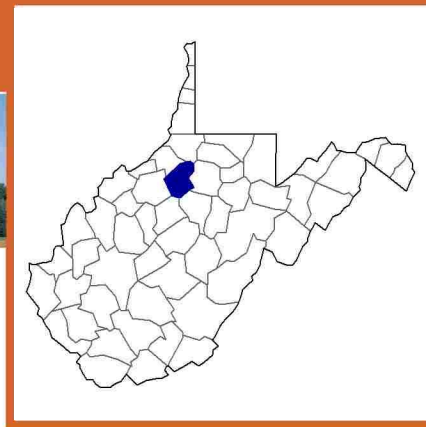


## **Doddridge County, West Virginia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>**

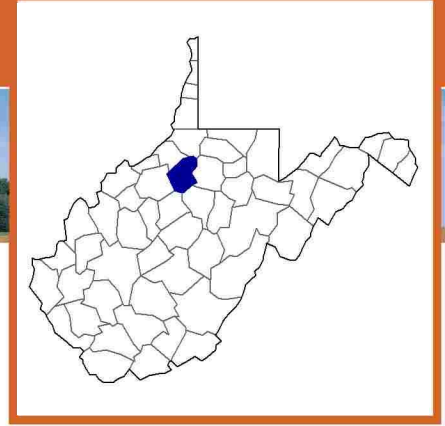


## Doddridge County, West Virginia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

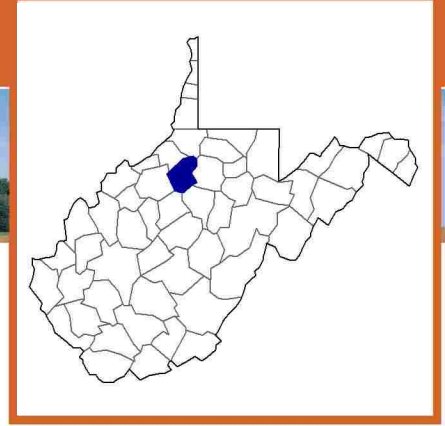


## Doddridge County, West Virginia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

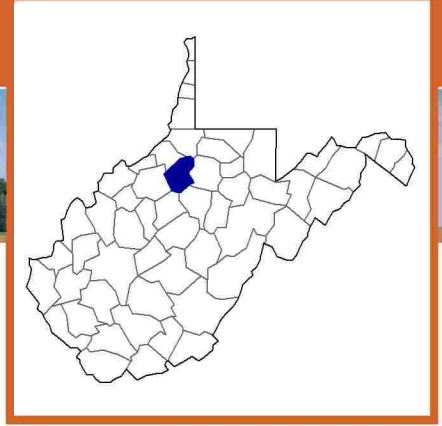

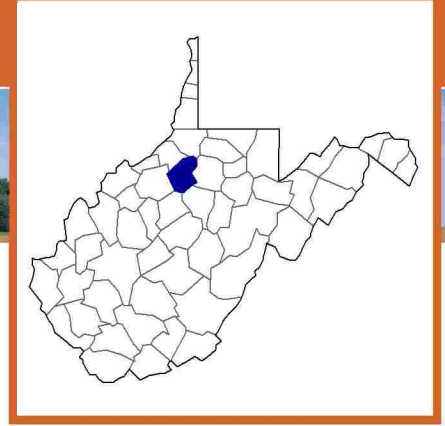


## Doddridge County, West Virginia Farms with White Producers<sup>a</sup>

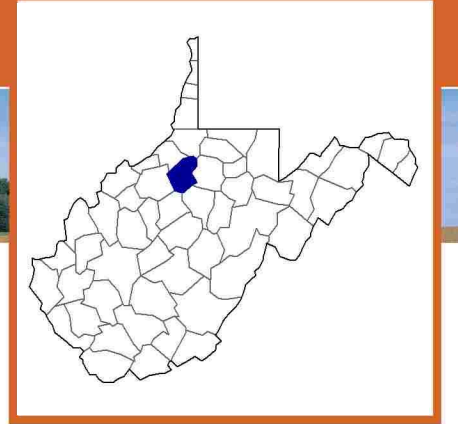
