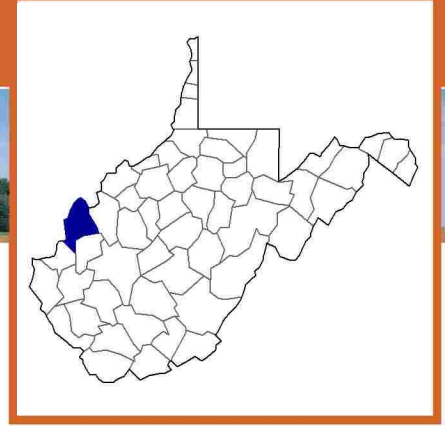

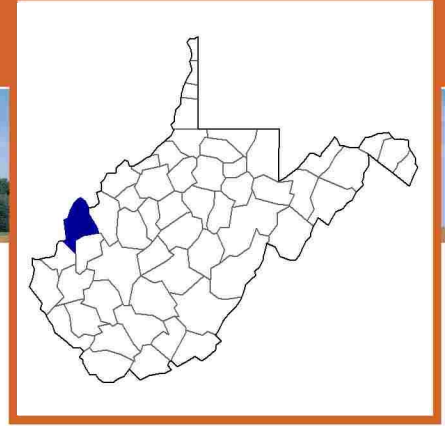

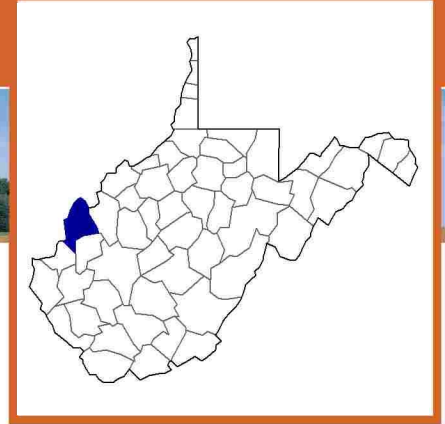

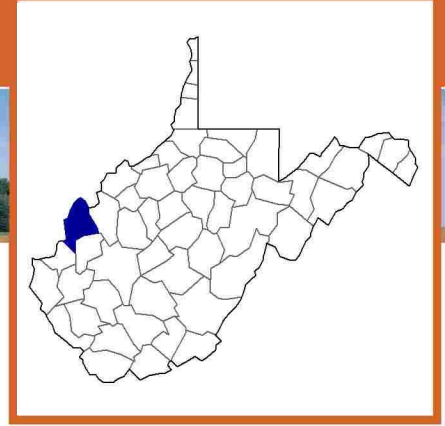

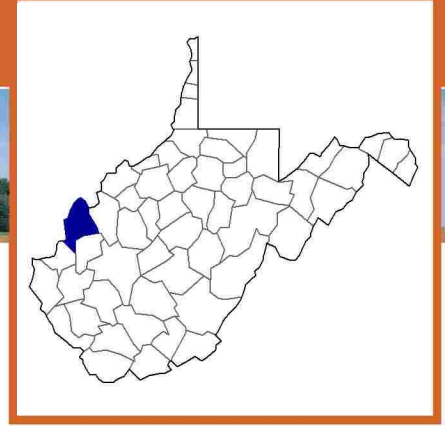

Mason County, West Virginia Farms with White Producers^a

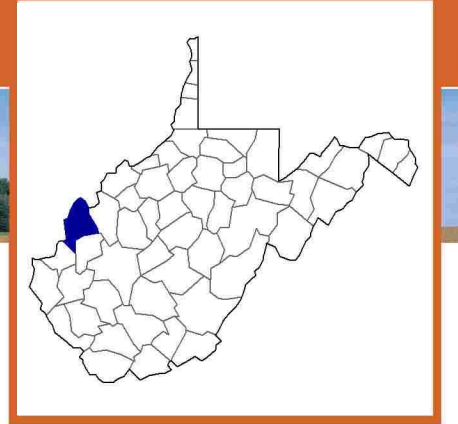
