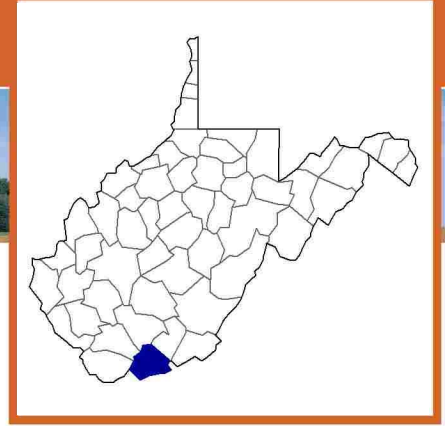

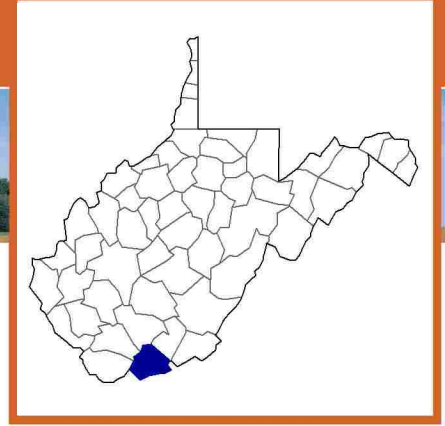


## **Mercer County, West Virginia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>**

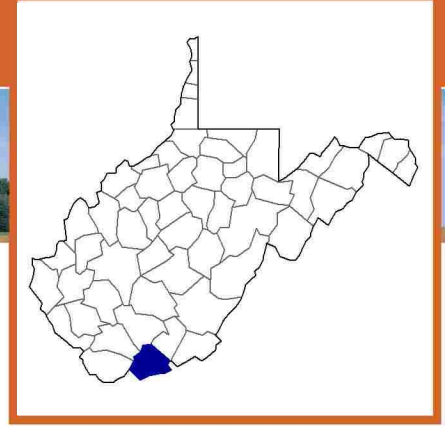


## **Mercer County, West Virginia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>**

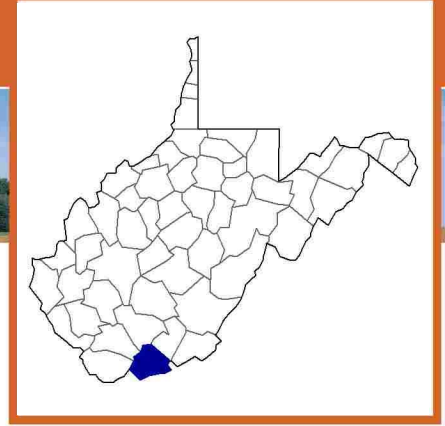

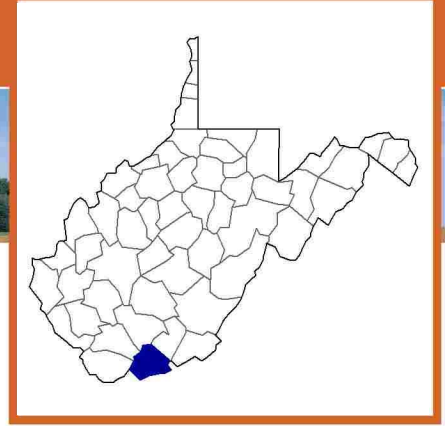

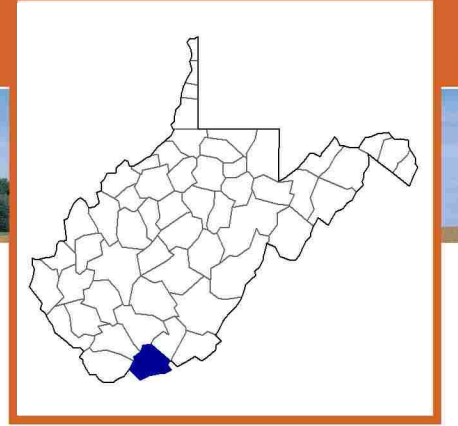
