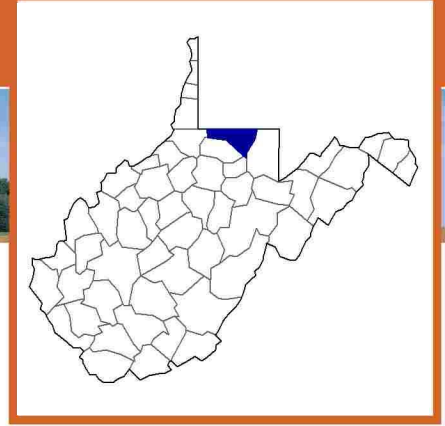


Monongalia County, West Virginia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

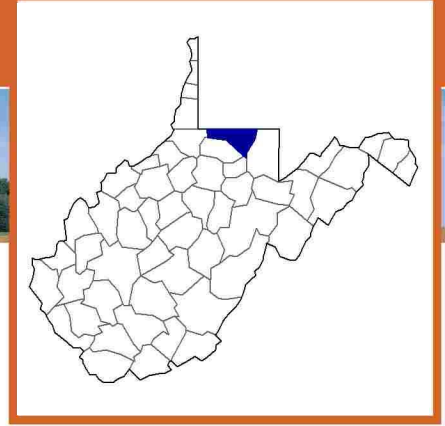

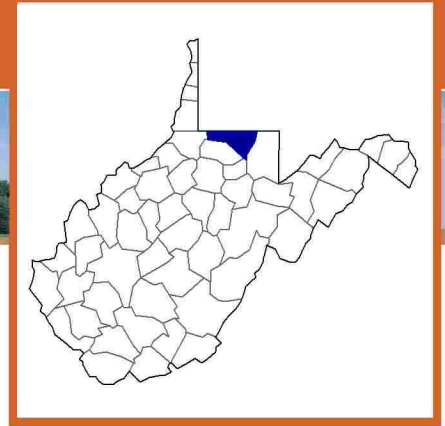

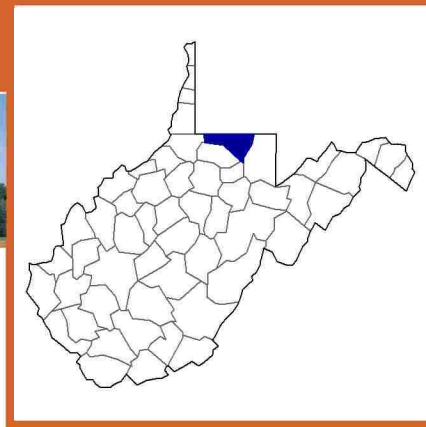

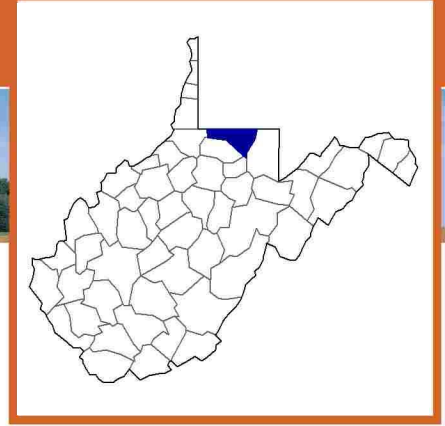

Monongalia County, West Virginia Farms with White Producers^a

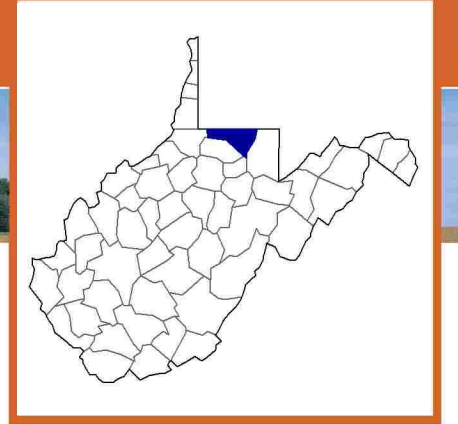
