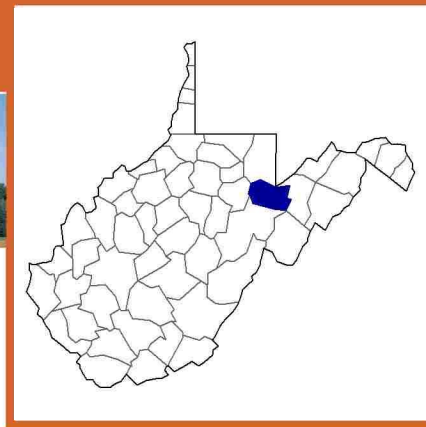

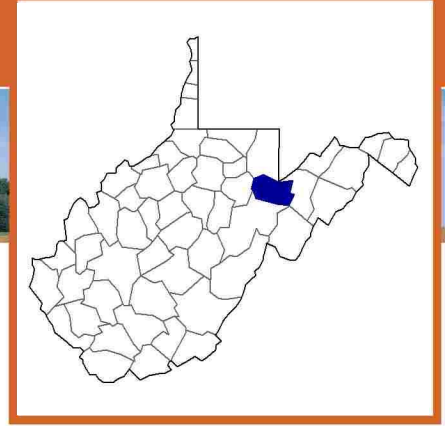


## Tucker County, West Virginia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

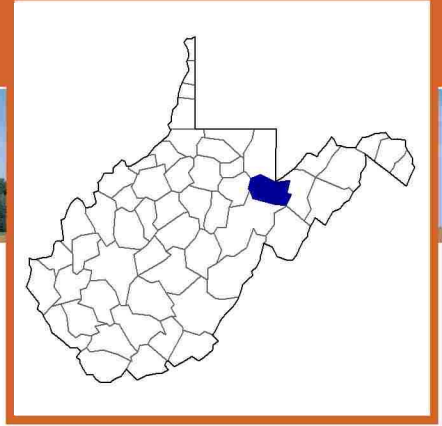


## Tucker County, West Virginia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

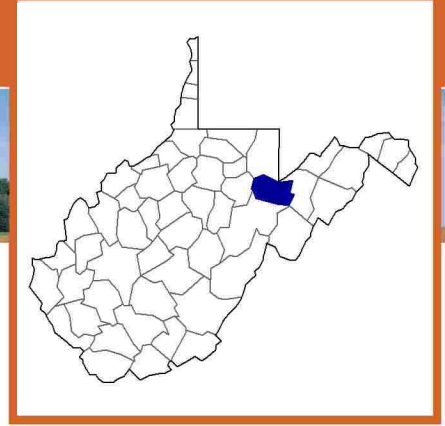

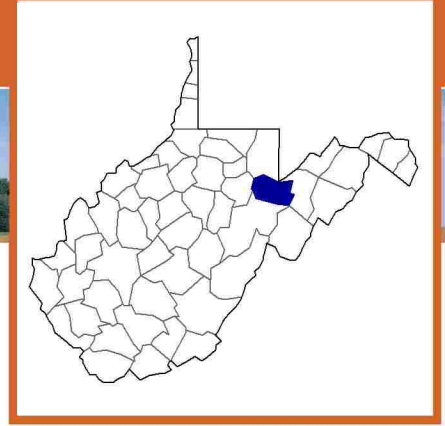

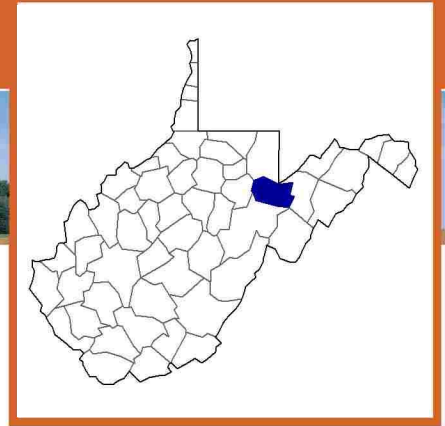
