


## Wirt County, West Virginia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>



## Wirt County, West Virginia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>



## Wirt County, West Virginia Farms with Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander Producers<sup>a</sup>






