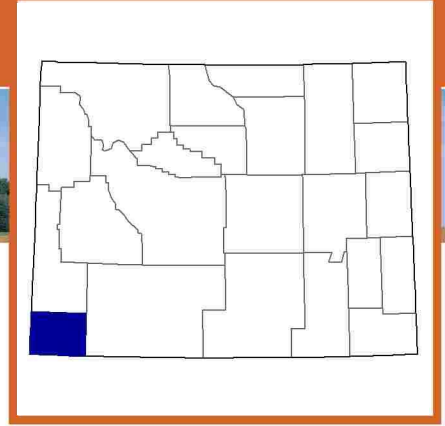

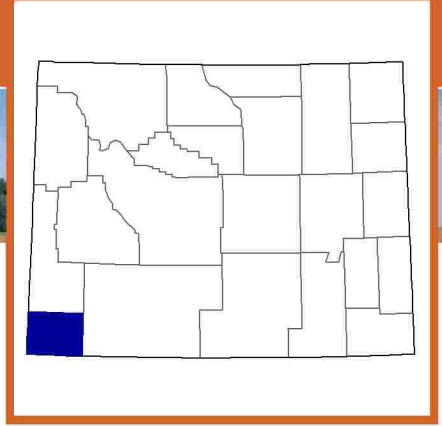
## Uinta County, Wyoming Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

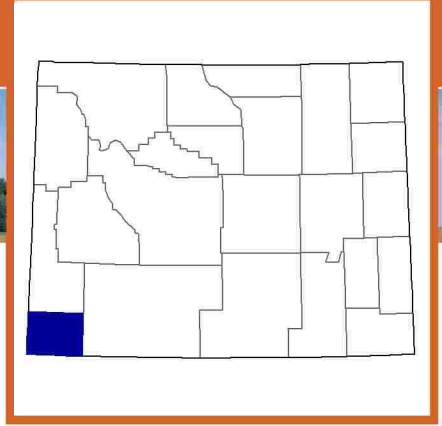


## Uinta County, Wyoming Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

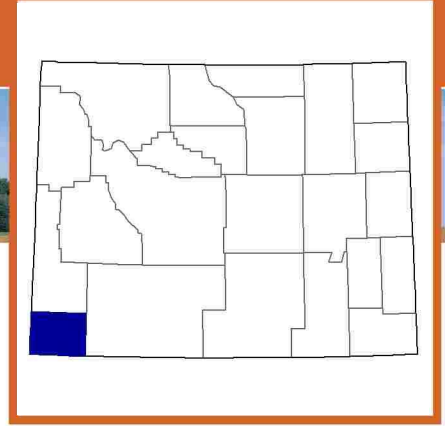

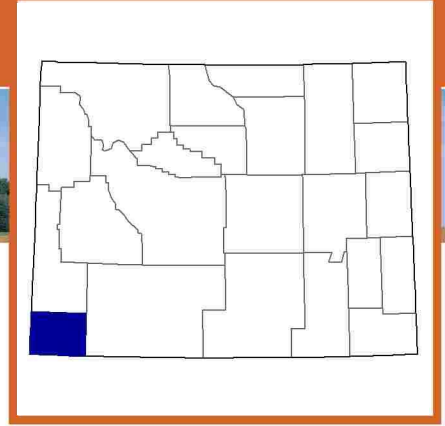

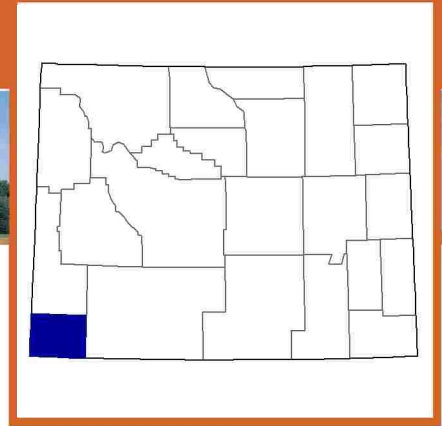


## Uinta County, Wyoming Farms with Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish Producers
