

Since the last Census of Agriculture in 2018 in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, the amount of land in farms, the value of agricultural products sold, and the number of farms increased. Both the number of small farms and the number of larger farms increased.

What is a "farm"? The Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands Census of Agriculture defines a farm as any place from which \$1,000 or more of agricultural products were produced and sold, or normally would have been sold, during the census year.

Farms and Land

In 2023, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands had 316 farms, an increase of 63 farms since 2018. These farms accounted for 2,833 acres of farmland, or 2.4% of all land in the Northern Mariana Islands. This was an increase of 1,318 acres (87%) from the 2018 level. During the same time, the average farm size increased 50%, from 6 acres in 2018 to 9 acres in 2023.
