

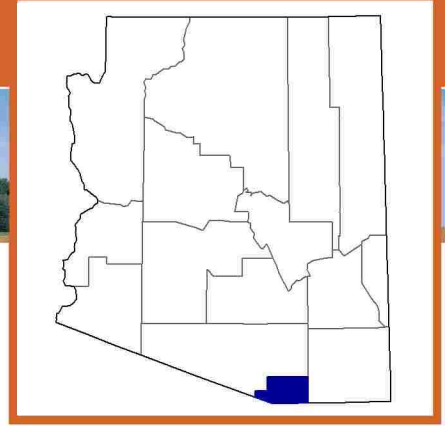

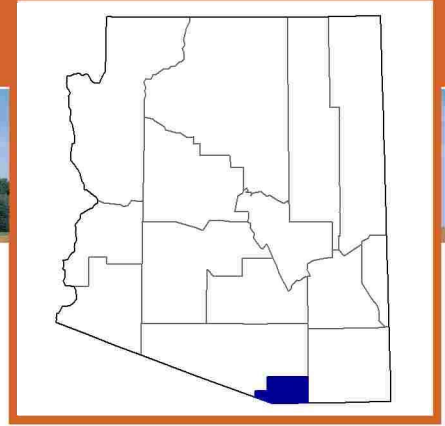


Santa Cruz County, Arizona Farms with Asian Producers^a

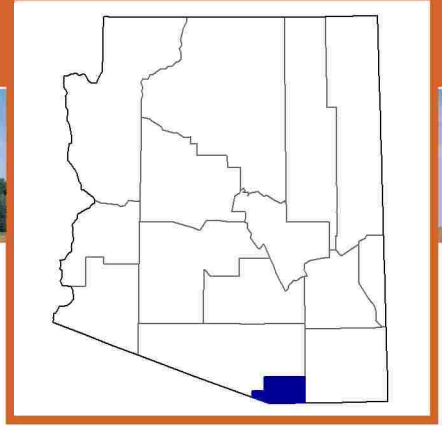

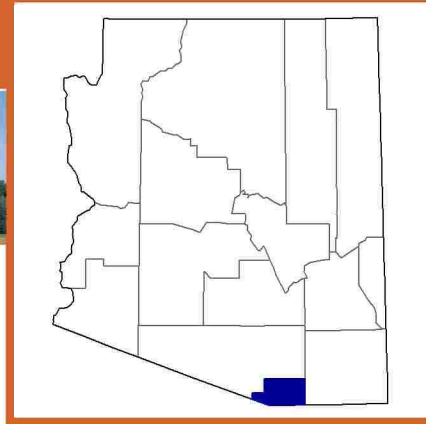

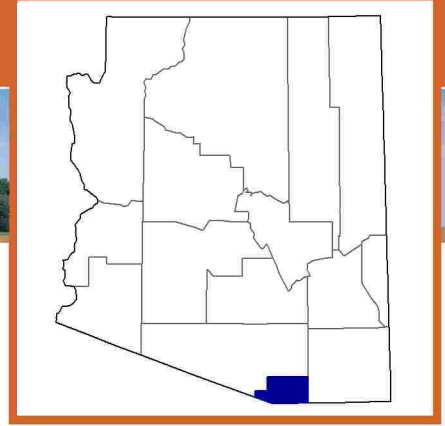
