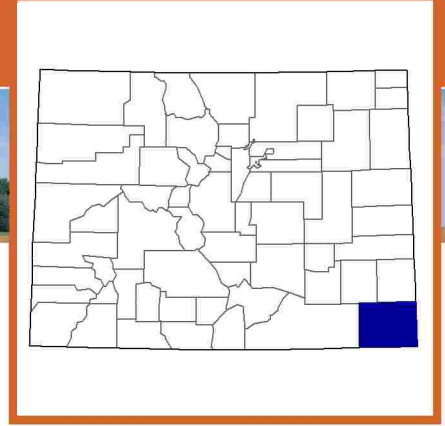

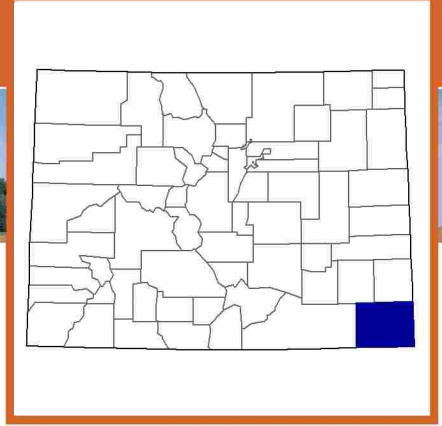


## Baca County, Colorado Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

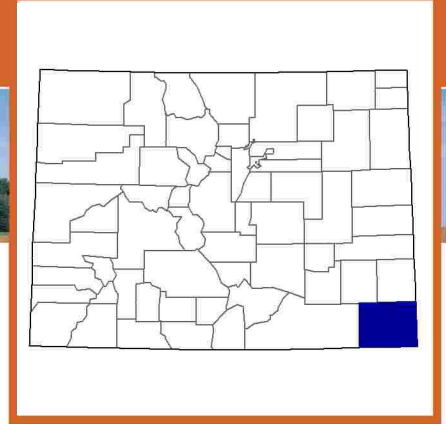

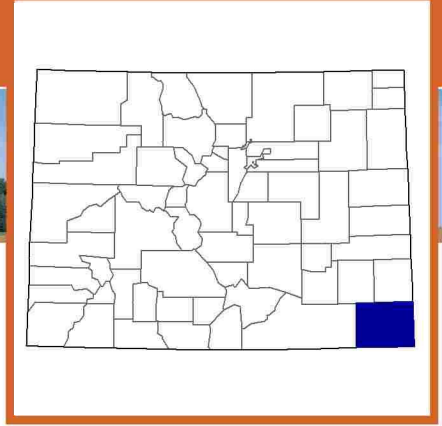

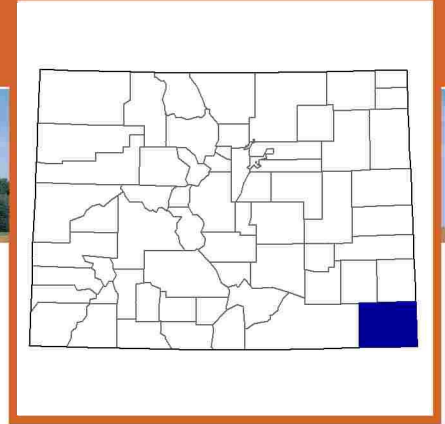

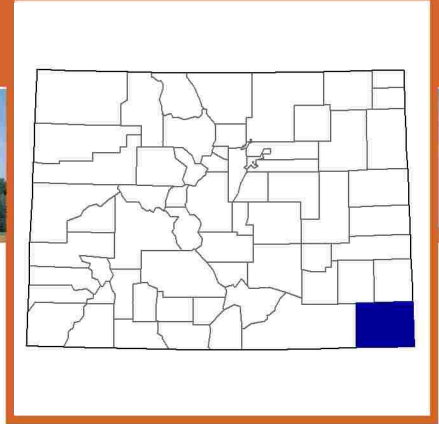
