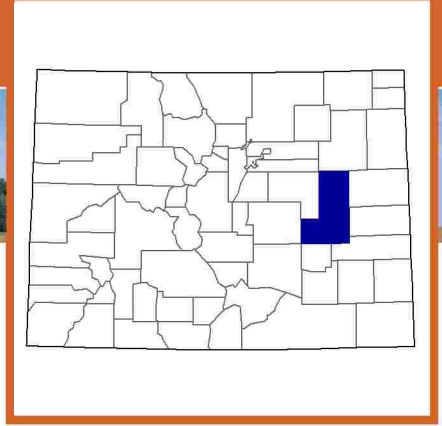


## Lincoln County, Colorado Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

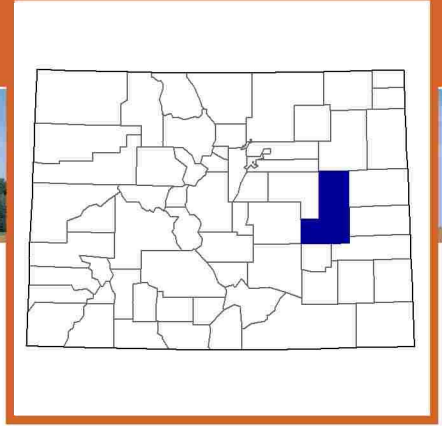


## Lincoln County, Colorado Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

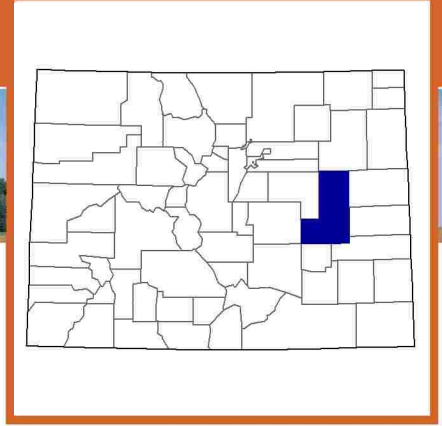


## Lincoln County, Colorado Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

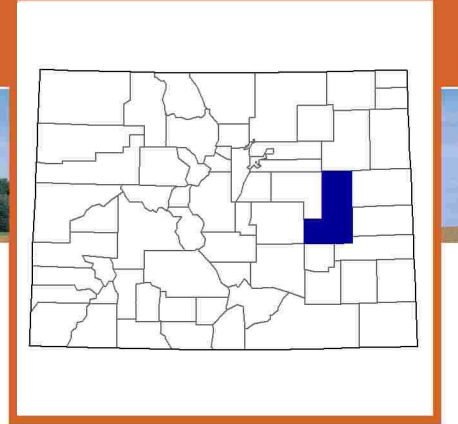

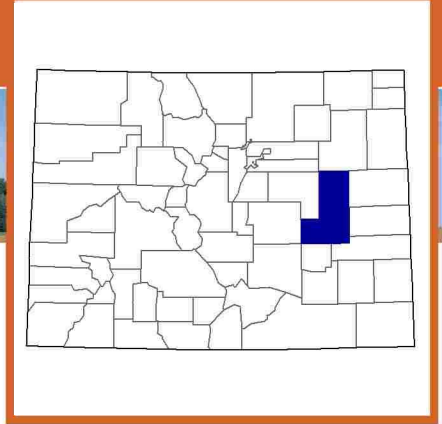

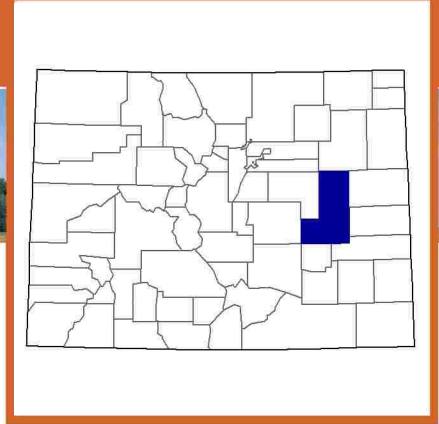
