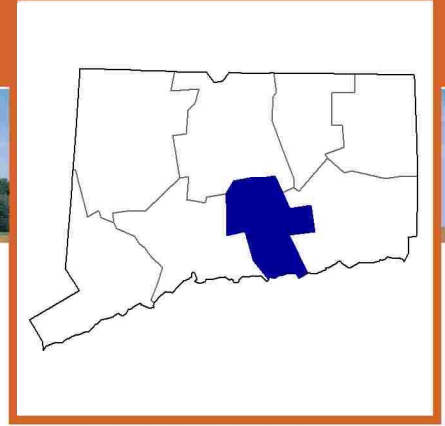


## Middlesex County, Connecticut Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

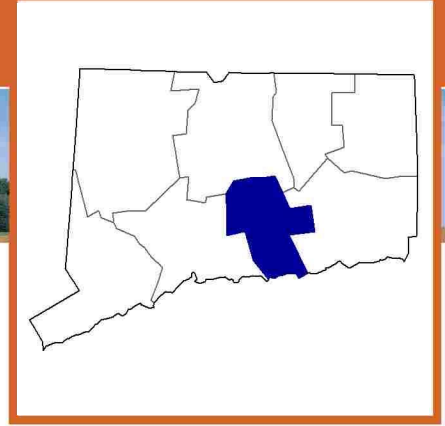


## Middlesex County, Connecticut Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

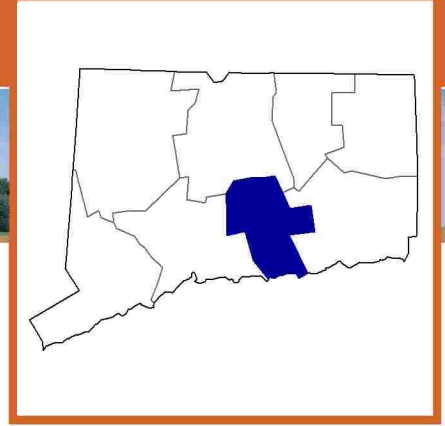


## Middlesex County, Connecticut Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

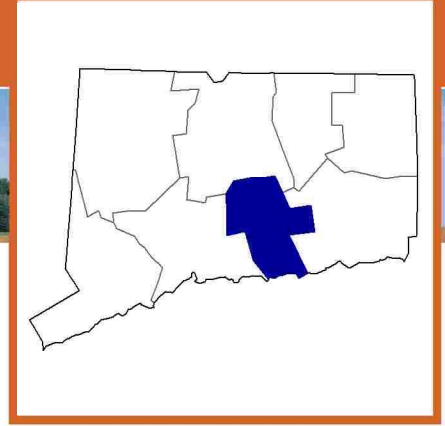

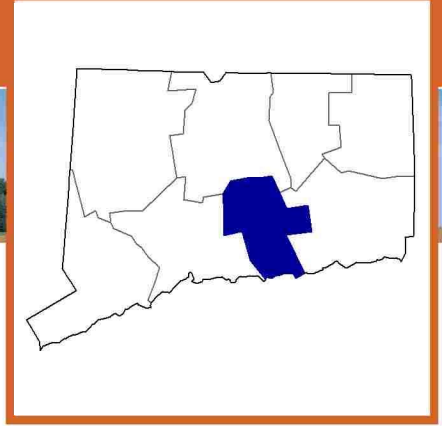

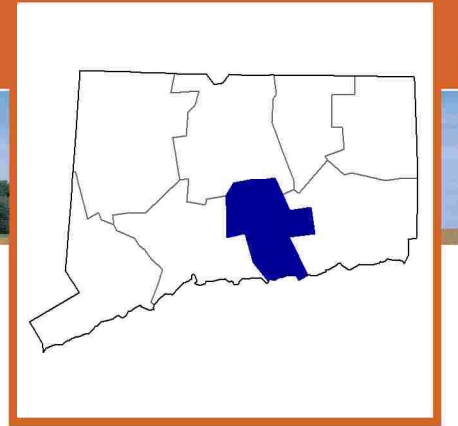
