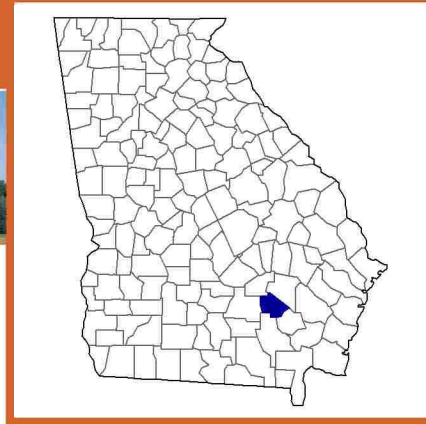


Bacon County, Georgia Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

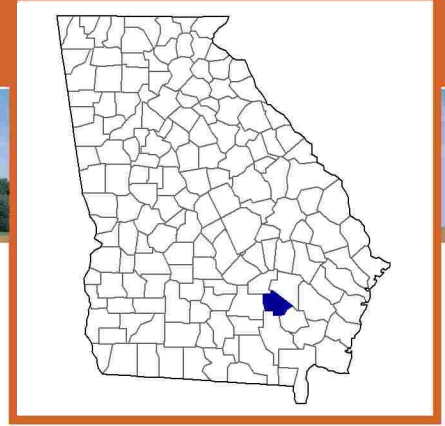

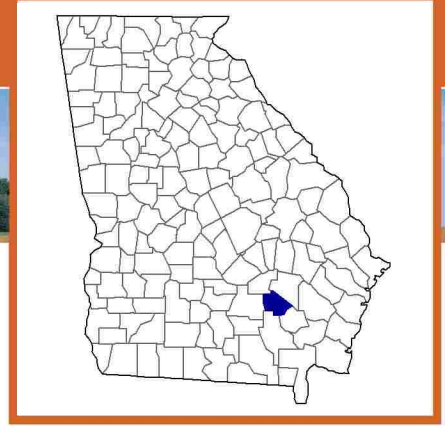

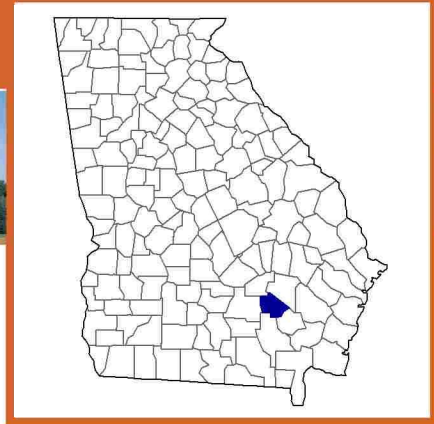

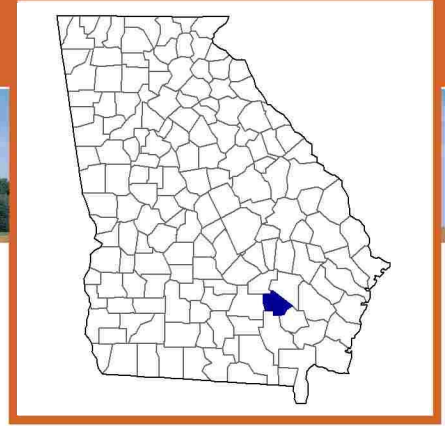

Bacon County, Georgia Farms with White Producers^a

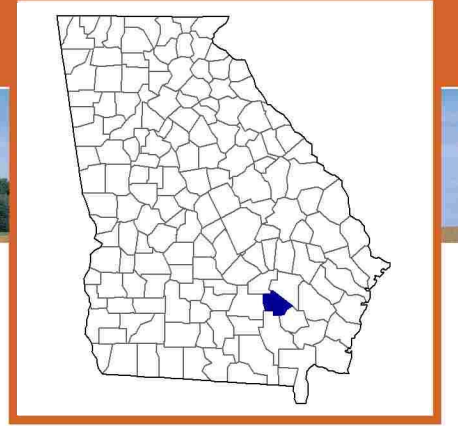
