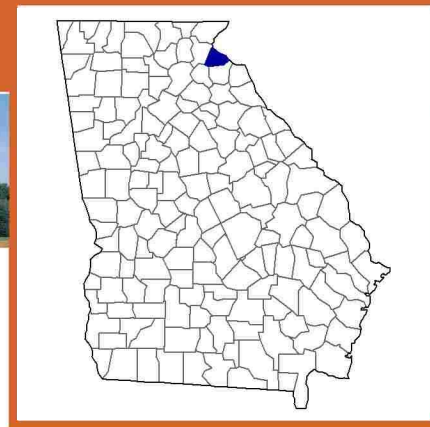

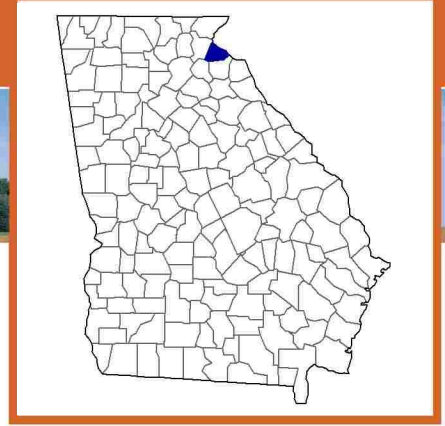


## Stephens County, Georgia Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

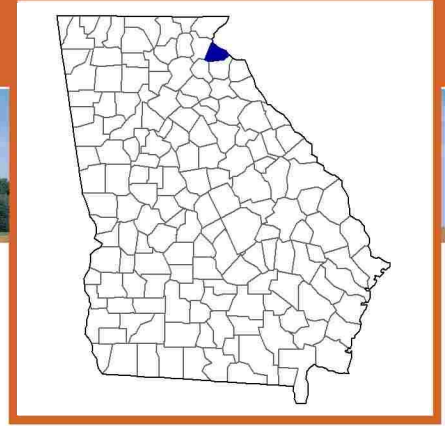


## Stephens County, Georgia Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

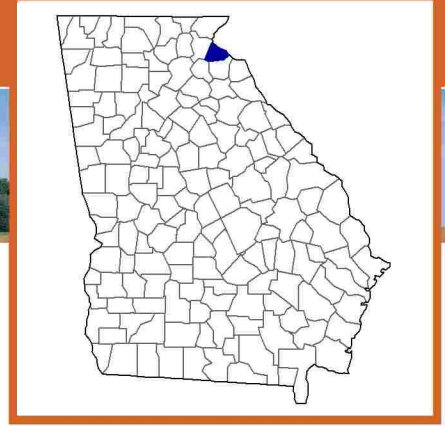

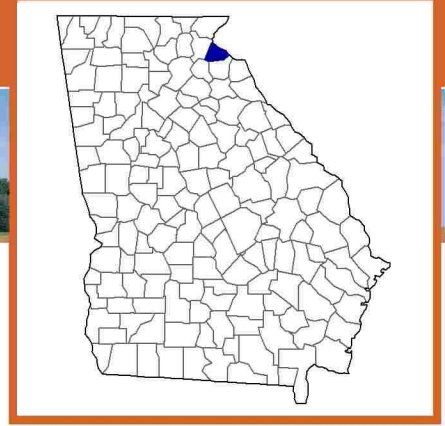

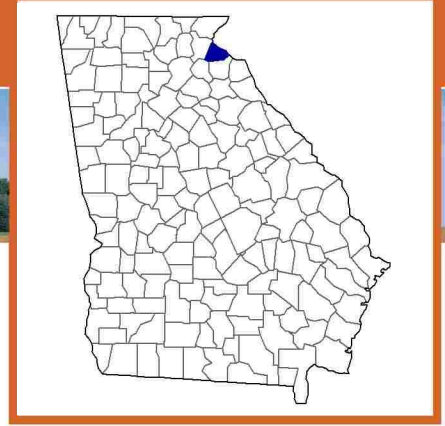
