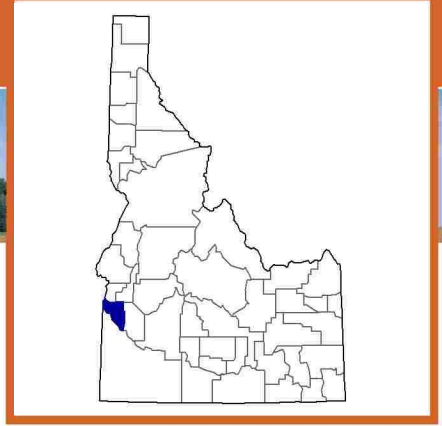

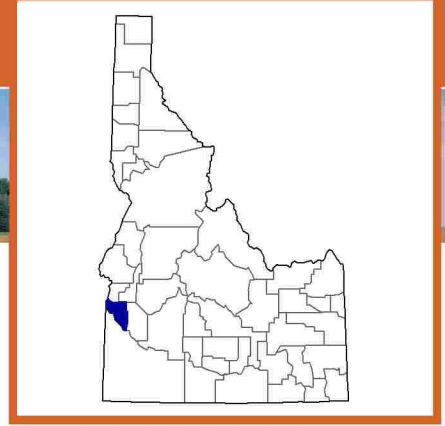

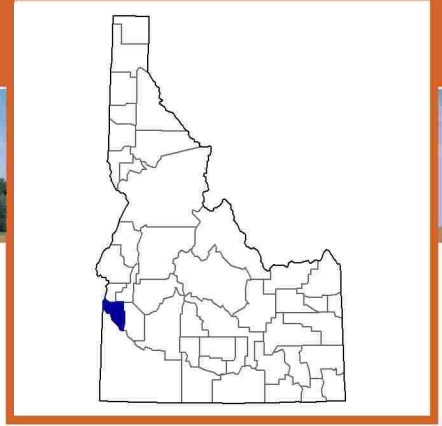

Canyon County, Idaho Farms with Black or African American Producers^a

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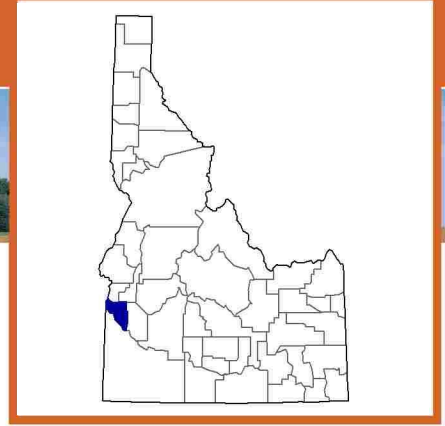

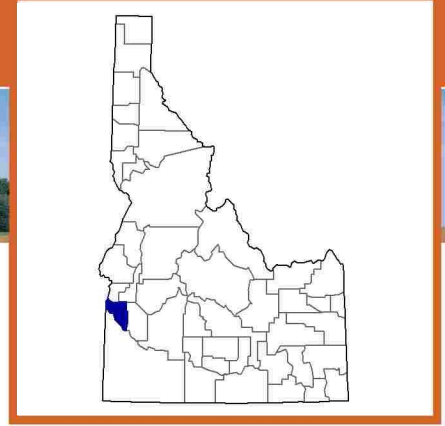

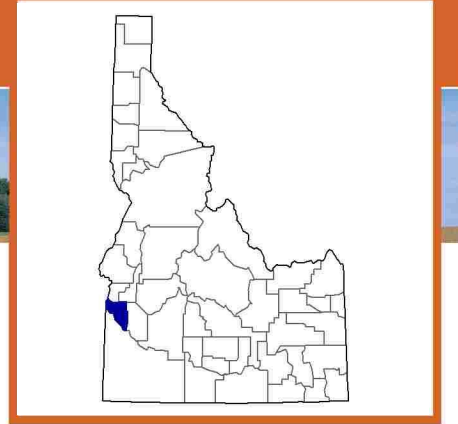
