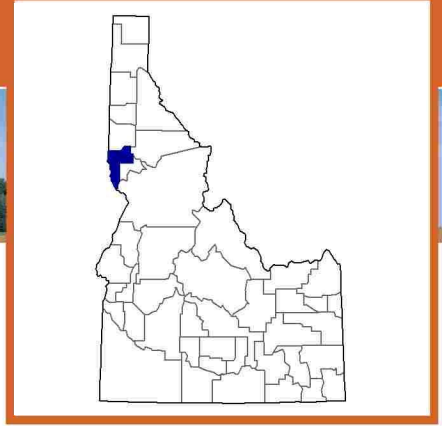


## Nez Perce County, Idaho Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

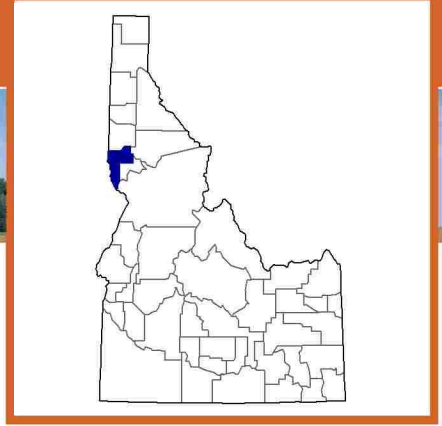


## Nez Perce County, Idaho Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

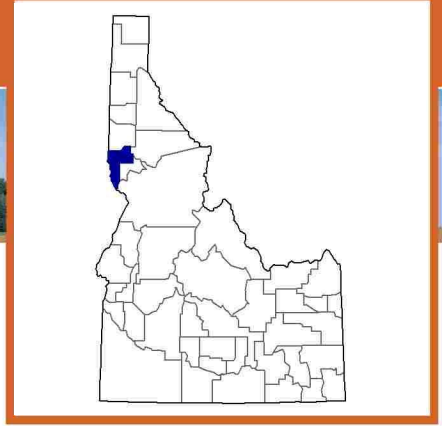

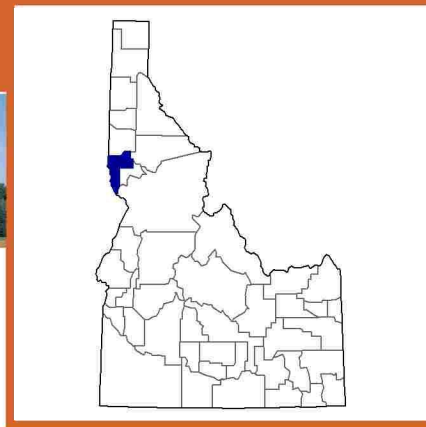

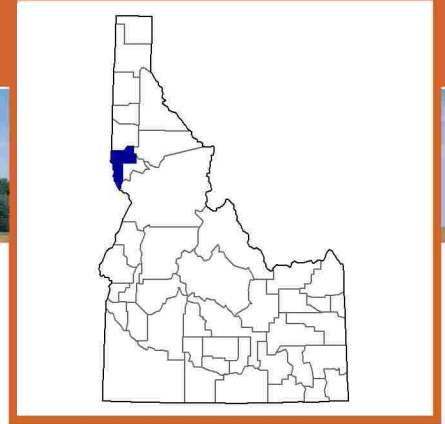

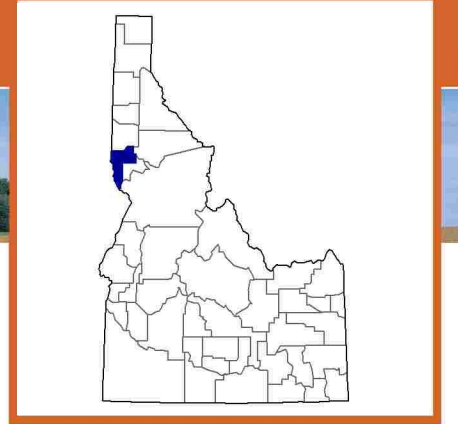
