

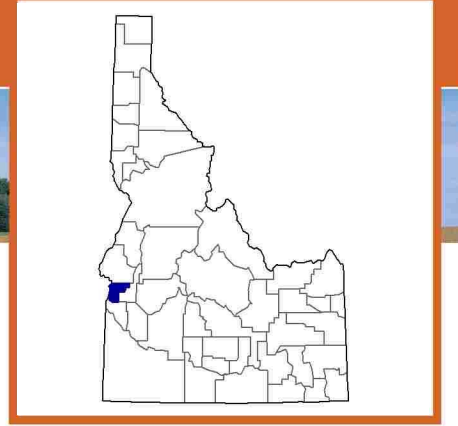

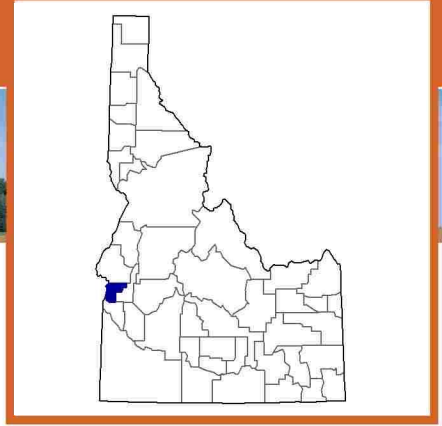


Payette County, Idaho Farms with Asian Producers^a

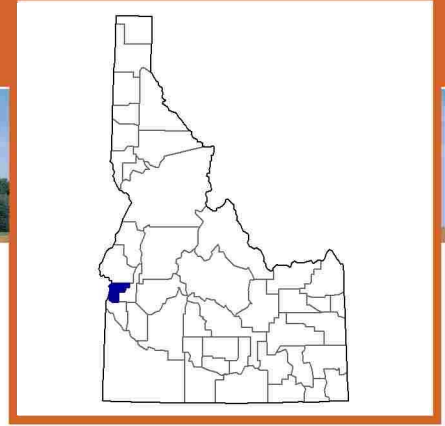

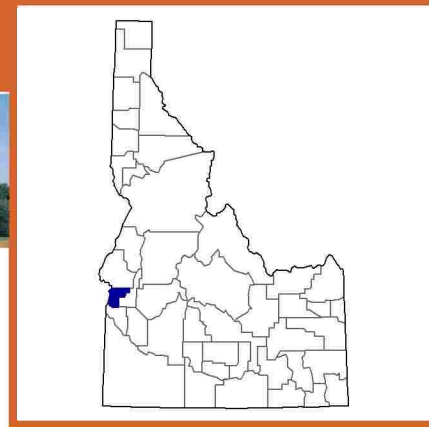

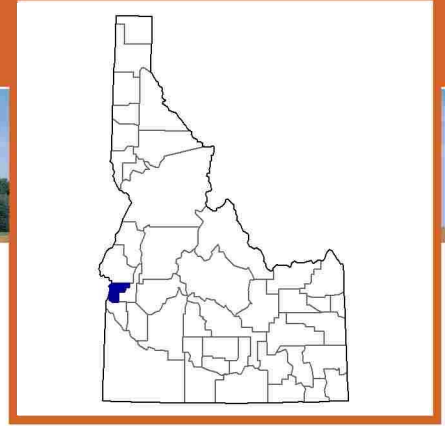


Payette County, Idaho Farms with White Producers^a



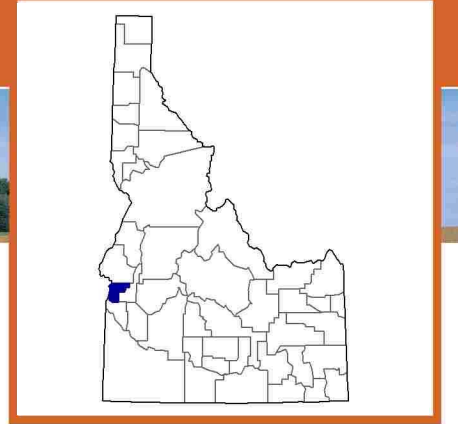
