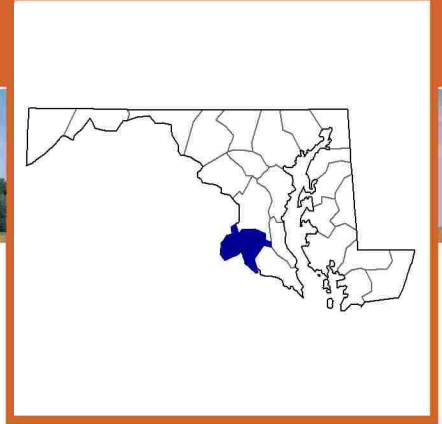


## Charles County, Maryland Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

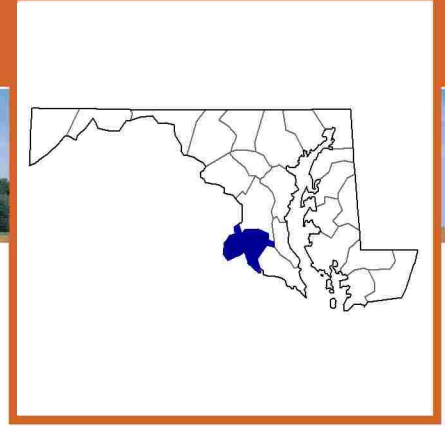


## Charles County, Maryland Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

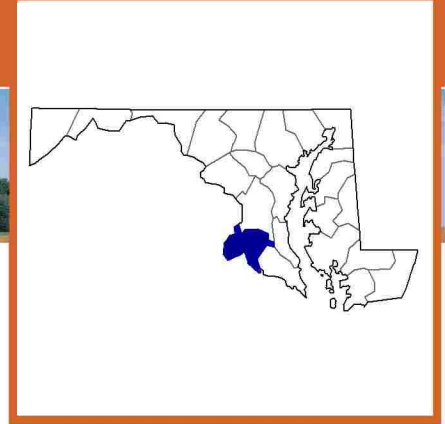


## Charles County, Maryland Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

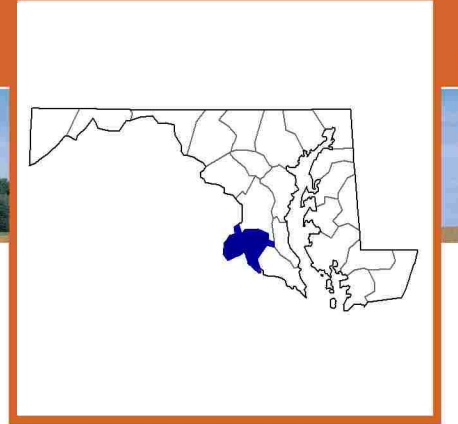

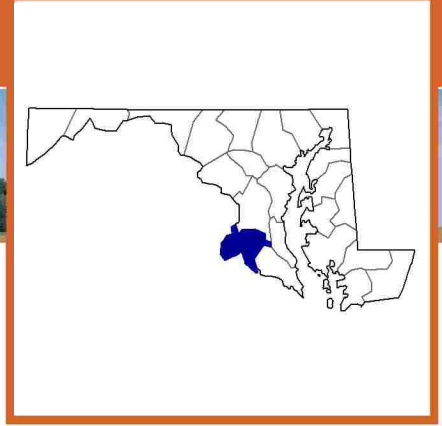

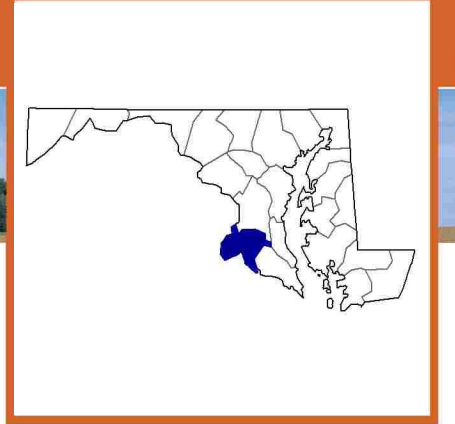
