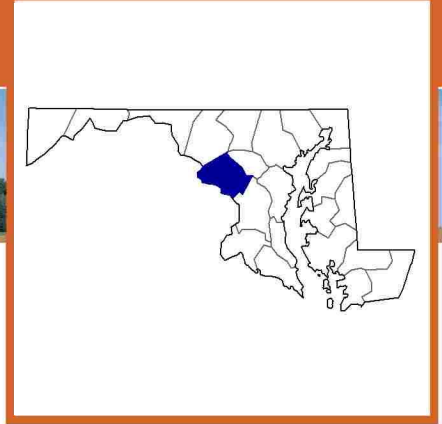


Montgomery County, Maryland Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

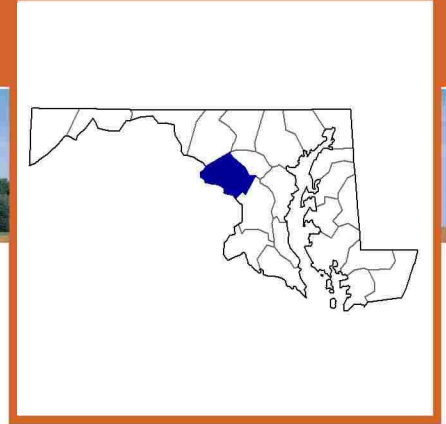

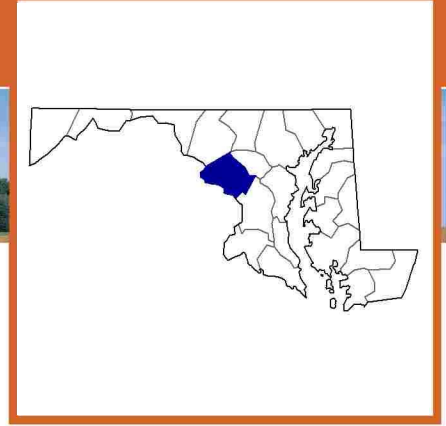

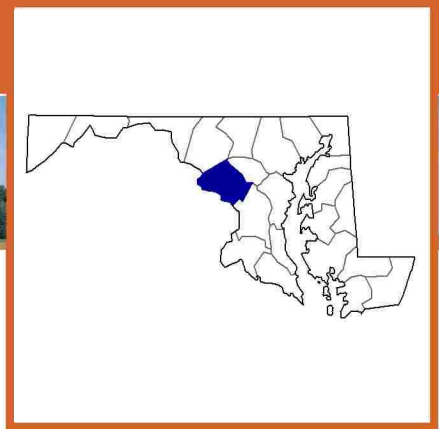

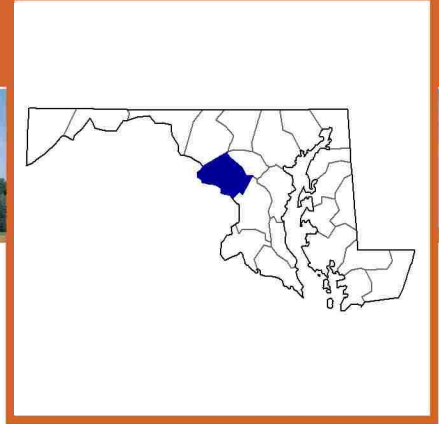
