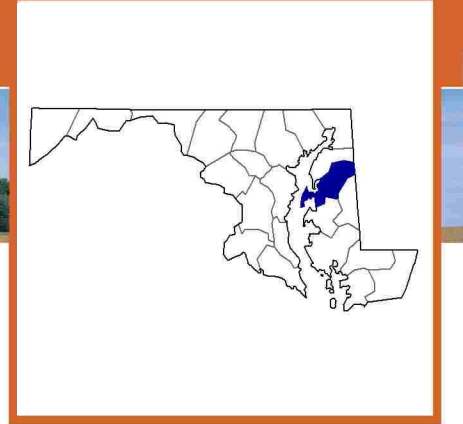


## Queen Anne's County, Maryland Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

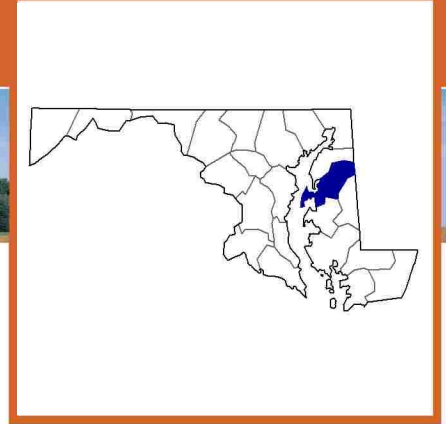


## Queen Anne's County, Maryland Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

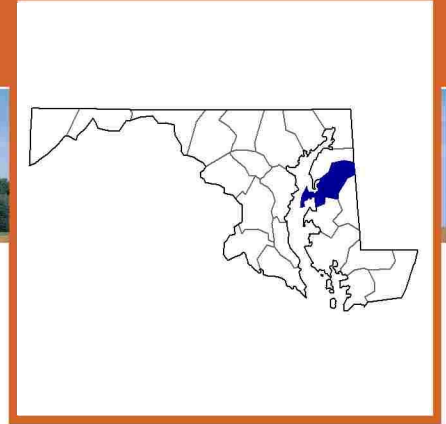

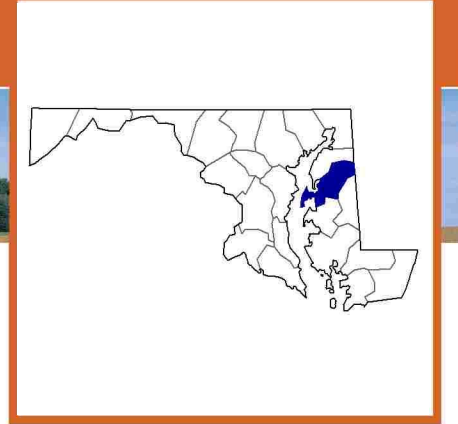

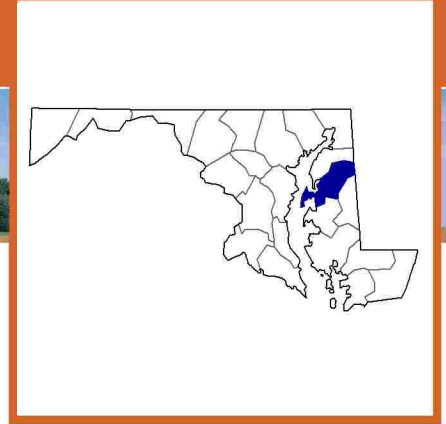

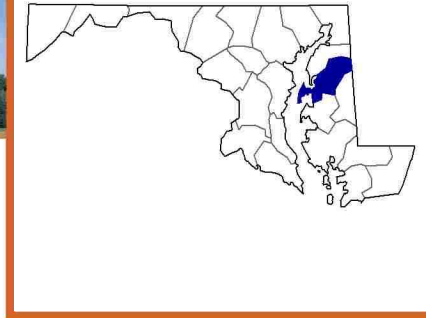
