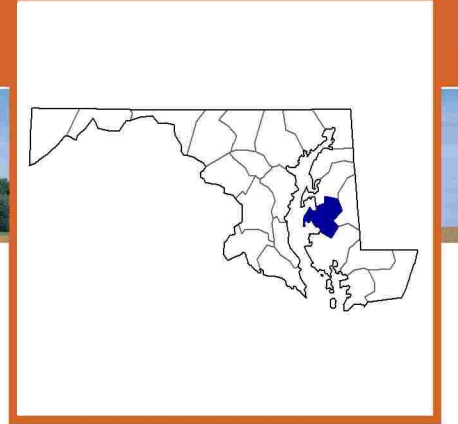

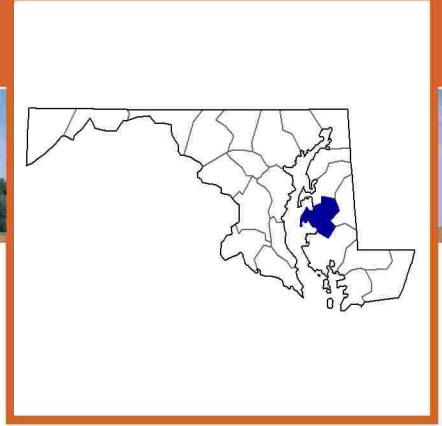


## Talbot County, Maryland Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

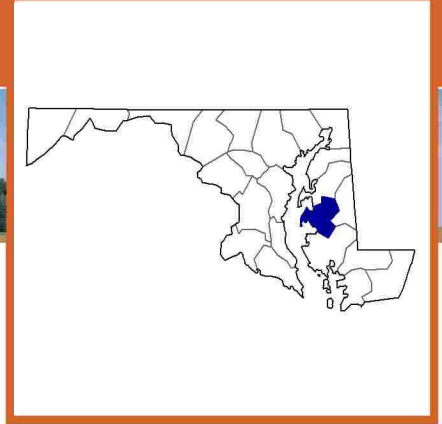

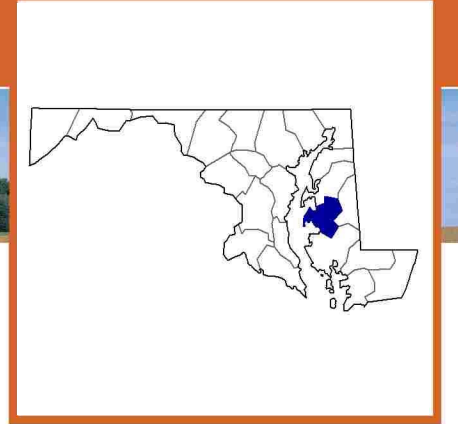

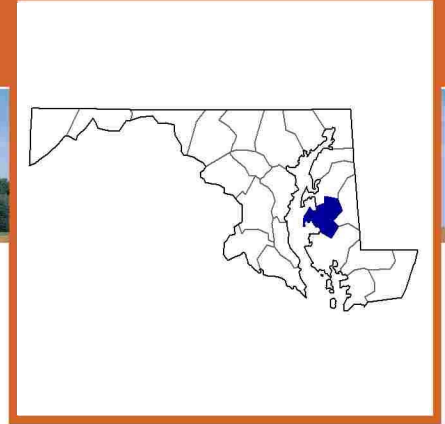

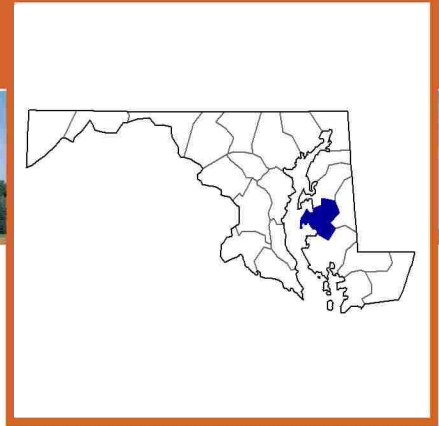
