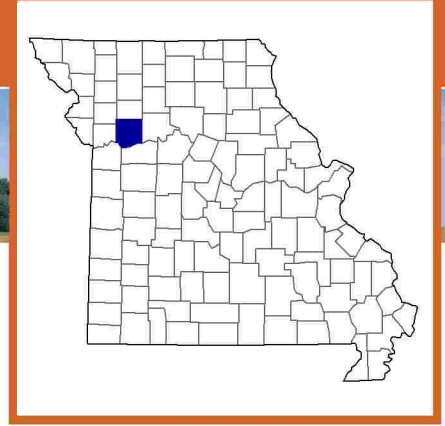




Ray County, Missouri Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

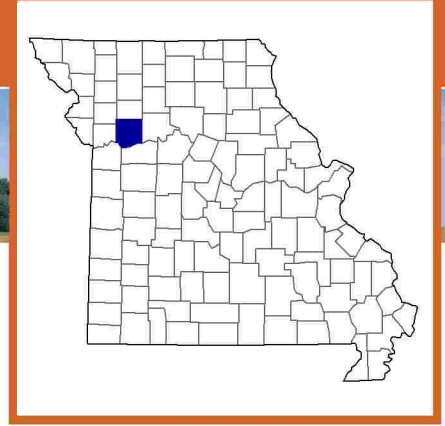
