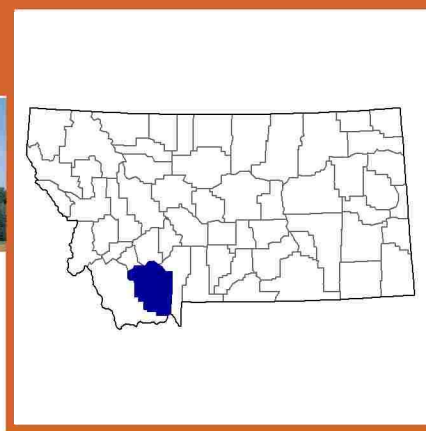


## Madison County, Montana Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

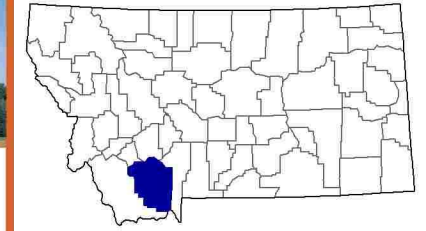


## Madison County, Montana Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

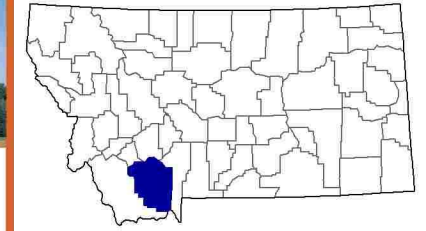

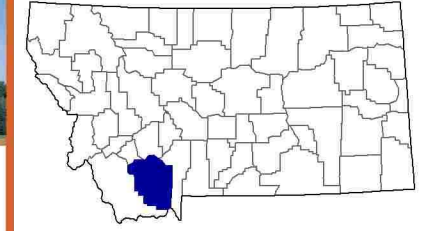

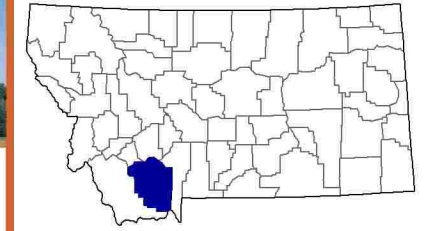
