

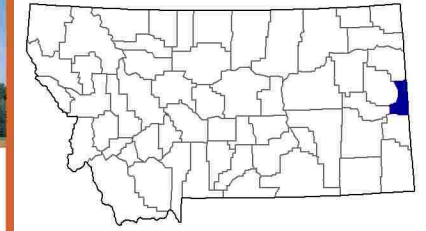


## Wibaux County, Montana Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

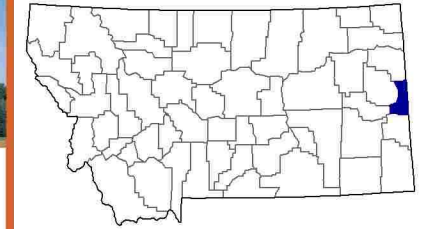


## Wibaux County, Montana Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

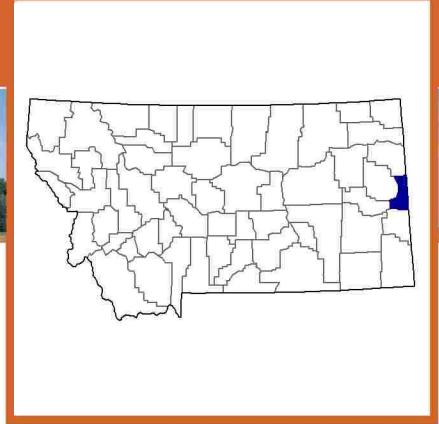


## Wibaux County, Montana Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

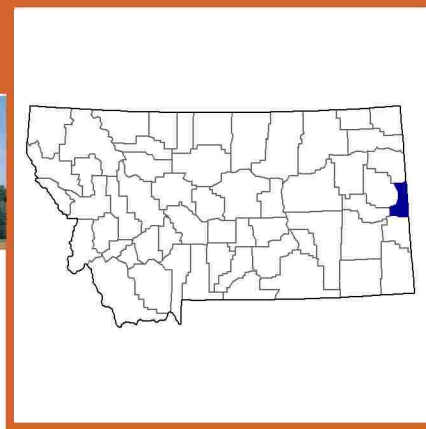

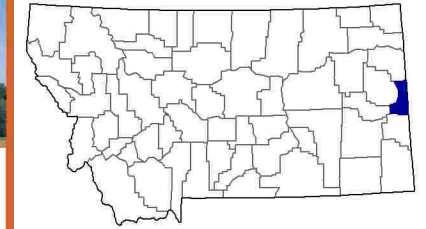

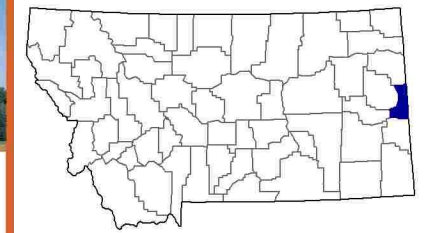
