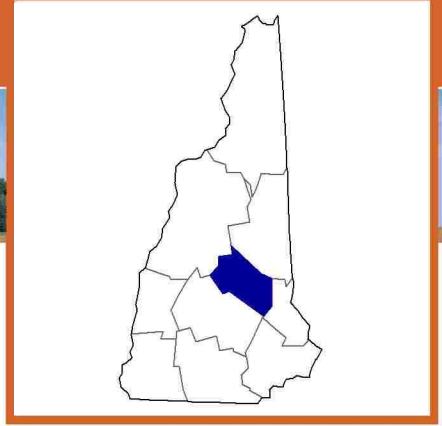


## Belknap County, New Hampshire Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

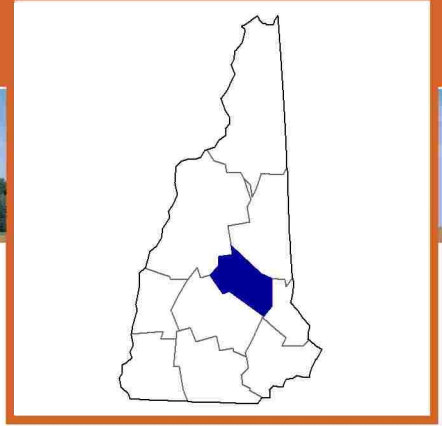


## Belknap County, New Hampshire Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

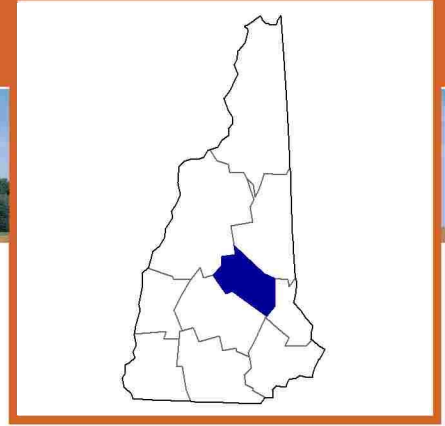

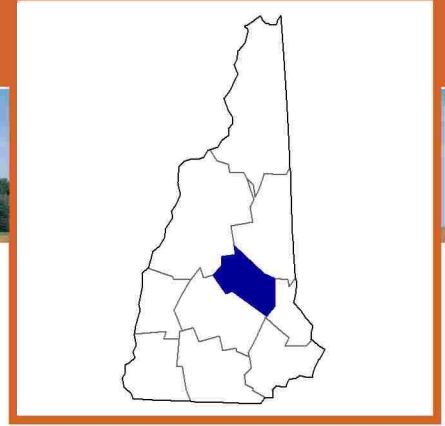

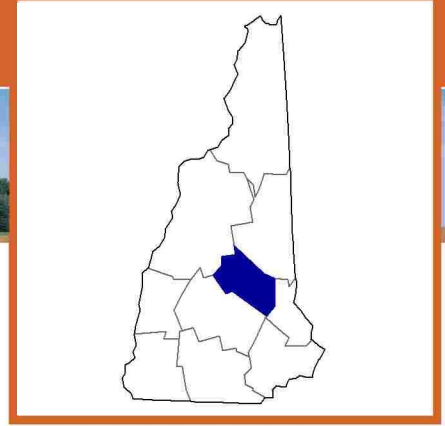

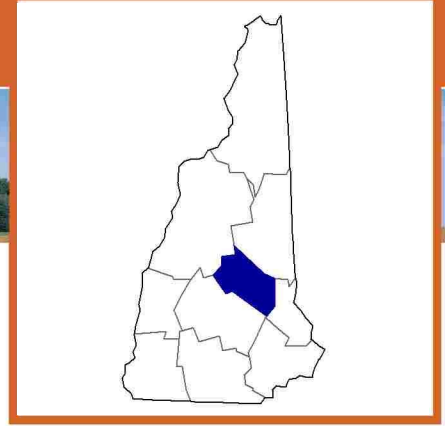
