

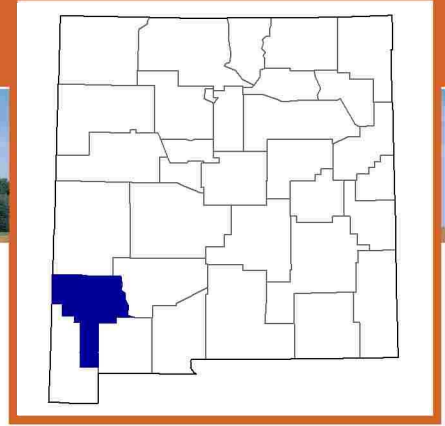

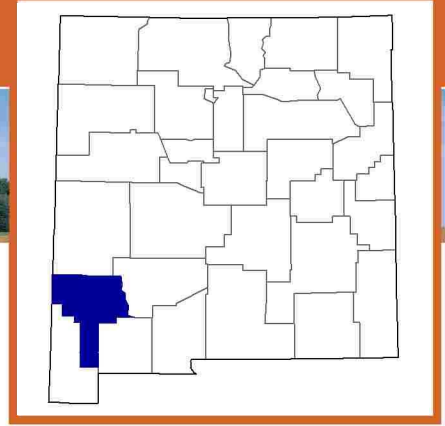


Grant County, New Mexico Farms with Asian Producers^a

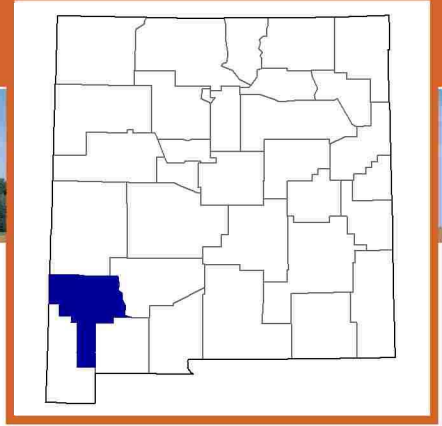

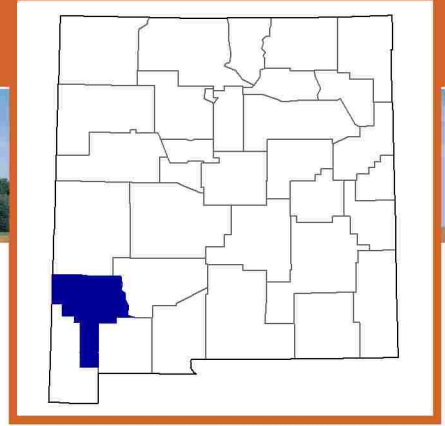

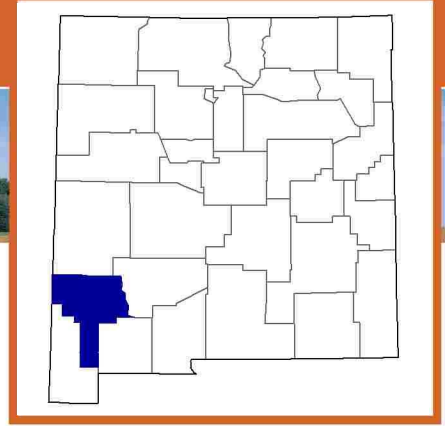


Grant County, New Mexico Farms with White Producers^a

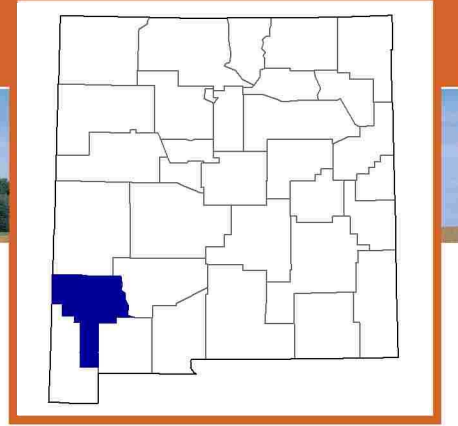
