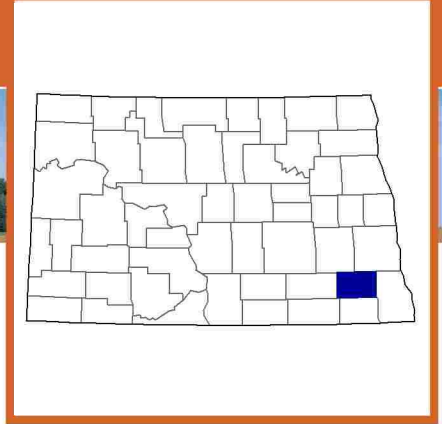

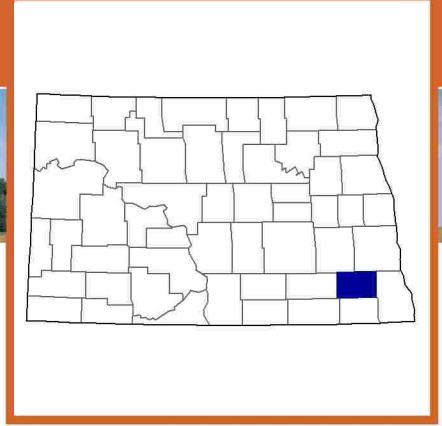


## Ransom County, North Dakota Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

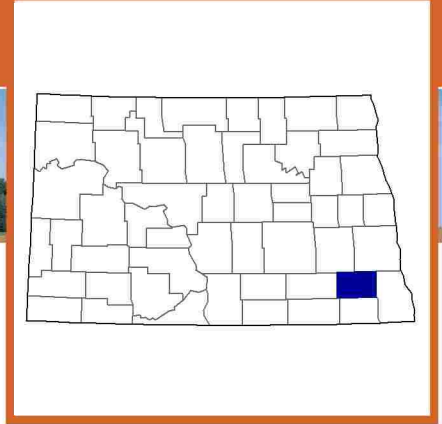


## Ransom County, North Dakota Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

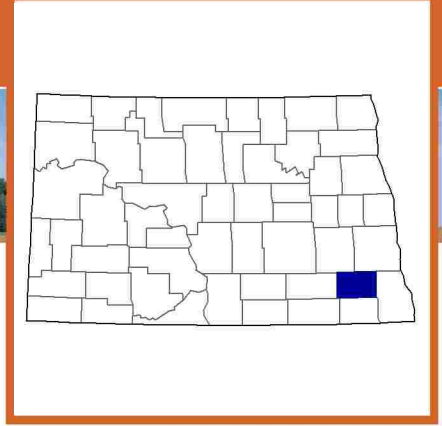

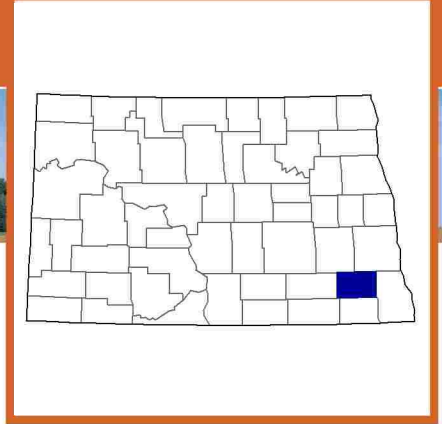

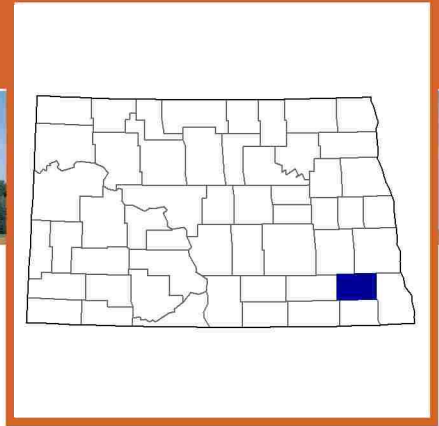
