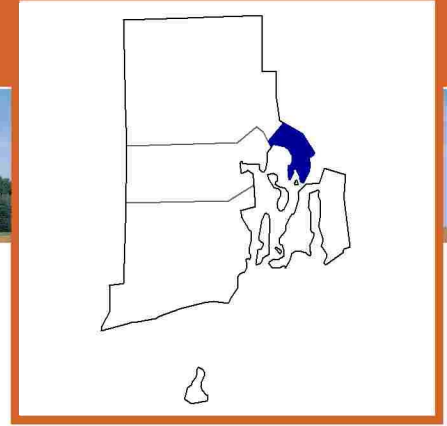

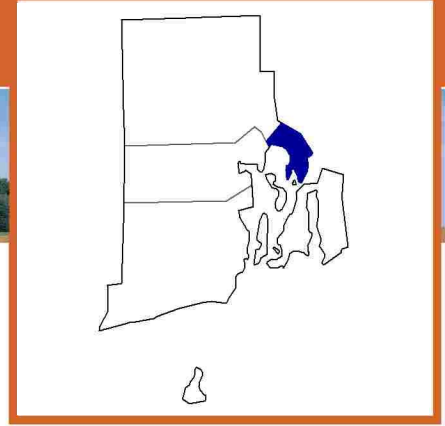
## Bristol County, Rhode Island Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

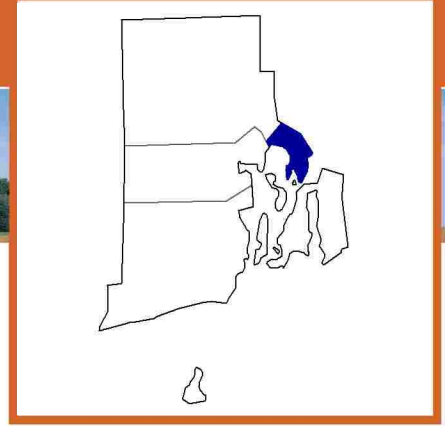

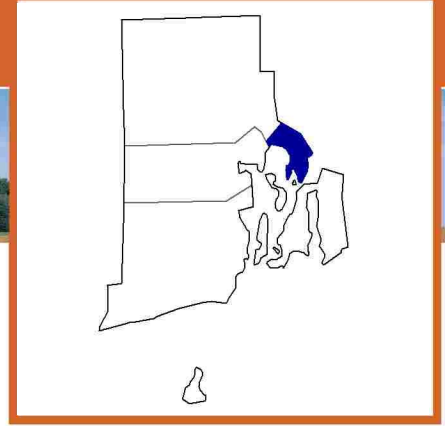

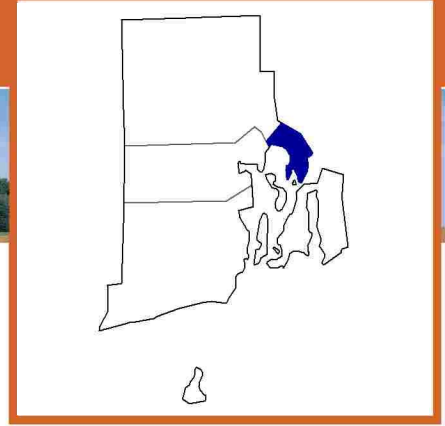

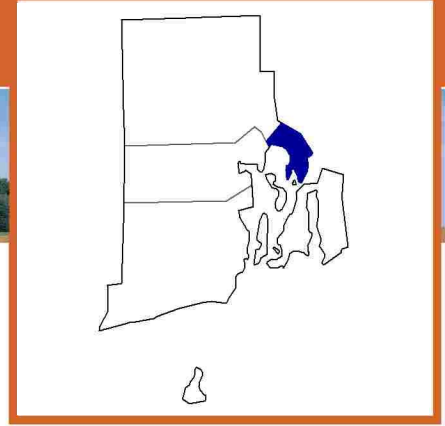
