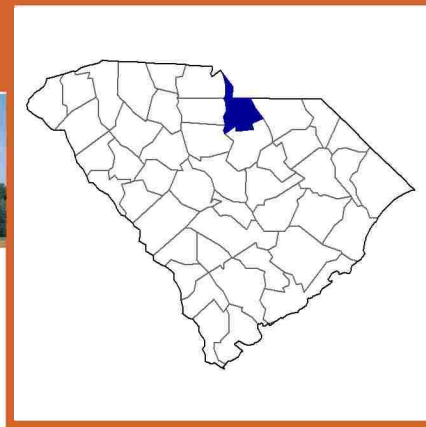


## Lancaster County, South Carolina Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

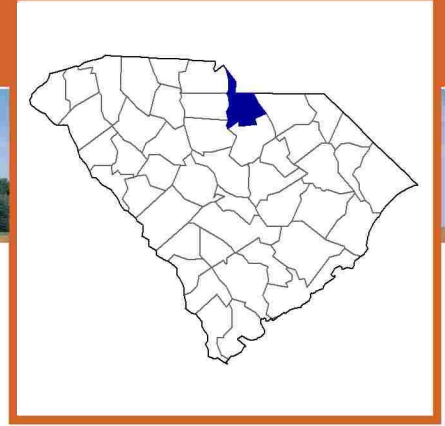


## Lancaster County, South Carolina Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

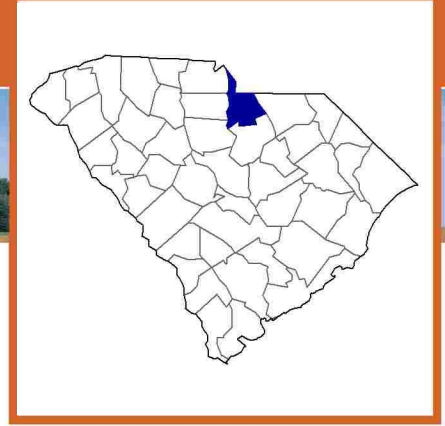


## Lancaster County, South Carolina Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

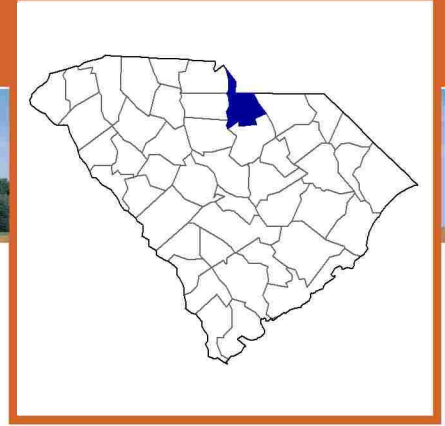

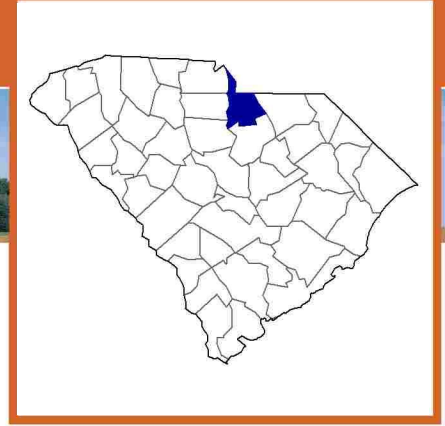

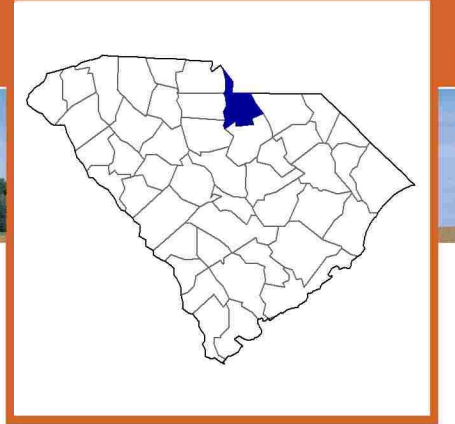
