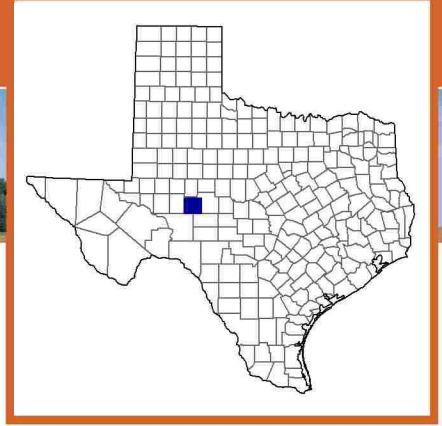

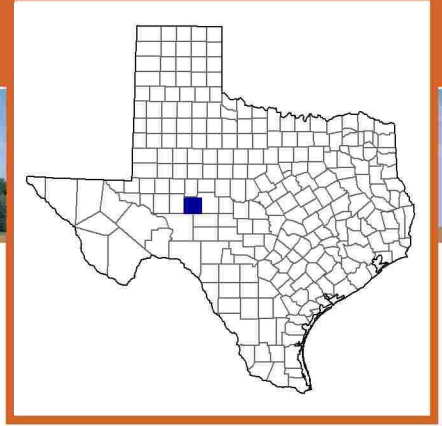


## Irion County, Texas Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

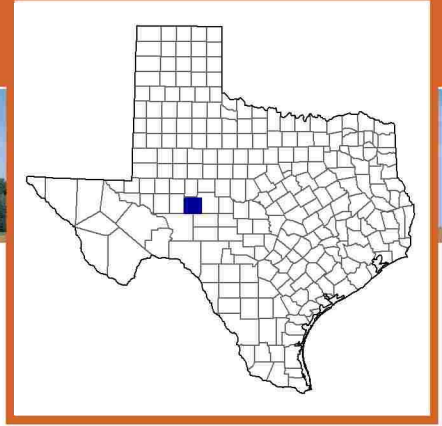


## Irion County, Texas Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

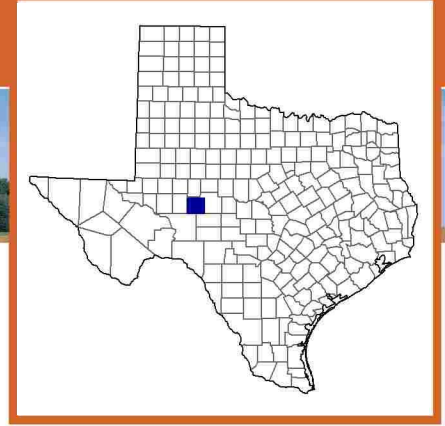

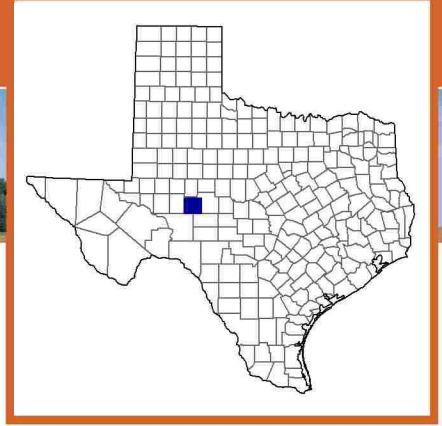

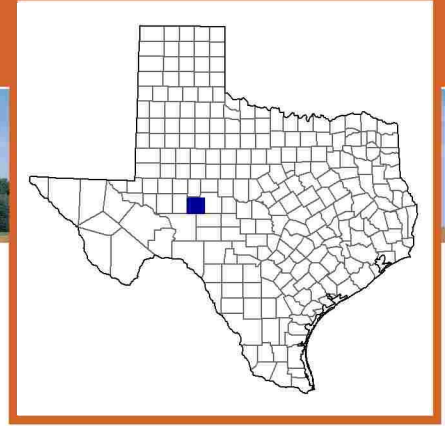
