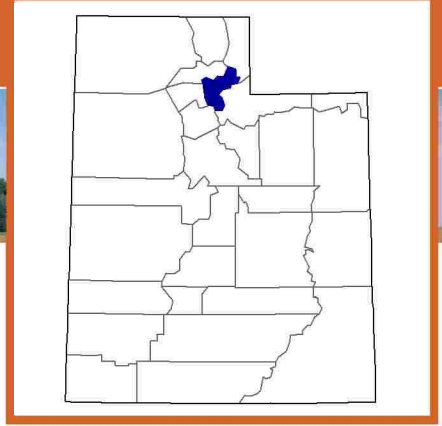


Morgan County, Utah Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers^a

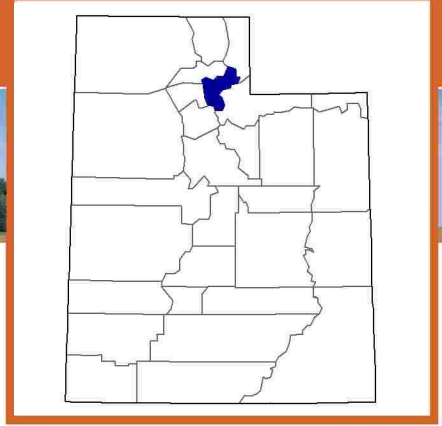

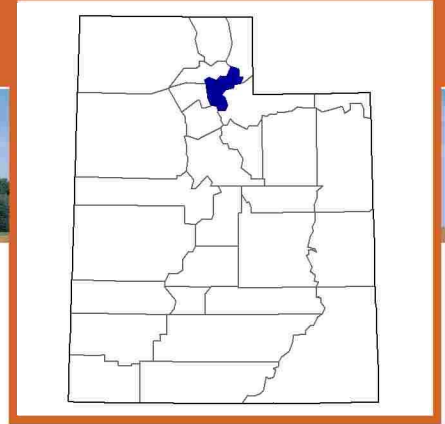

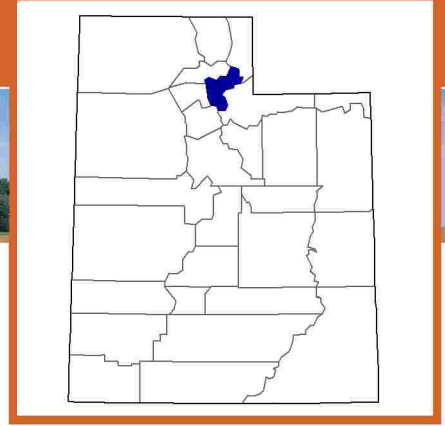
