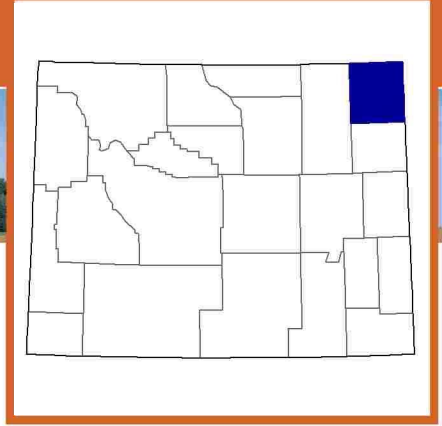

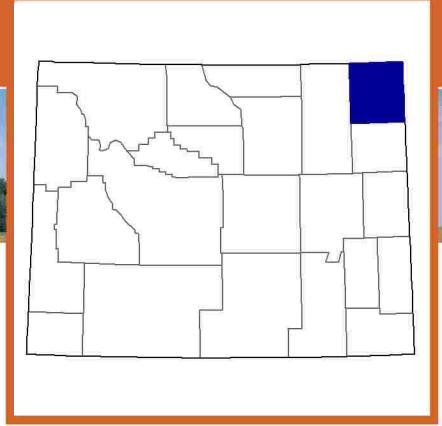

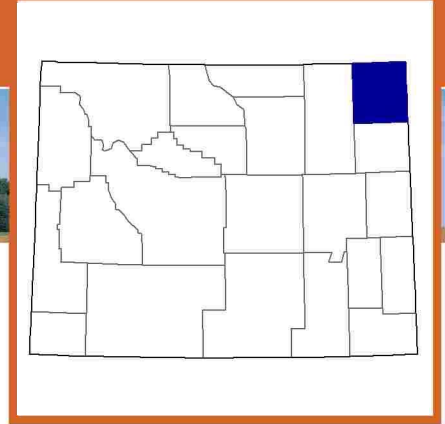

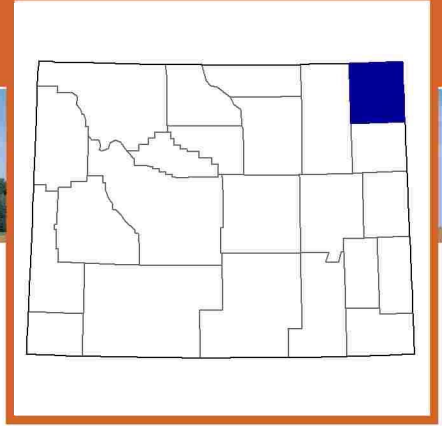

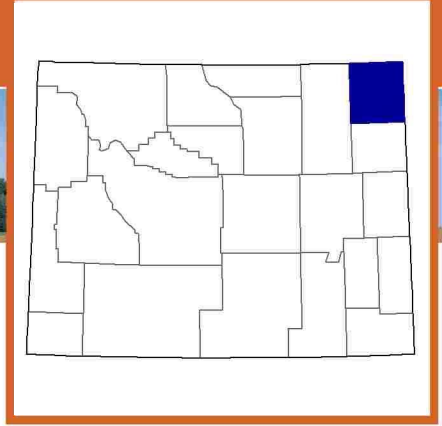


Crook County, Wyoming Farms with White Producers^a



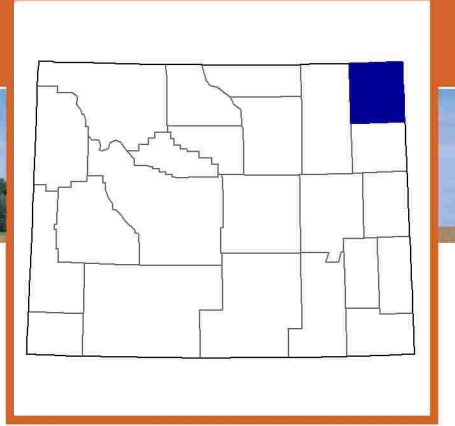
