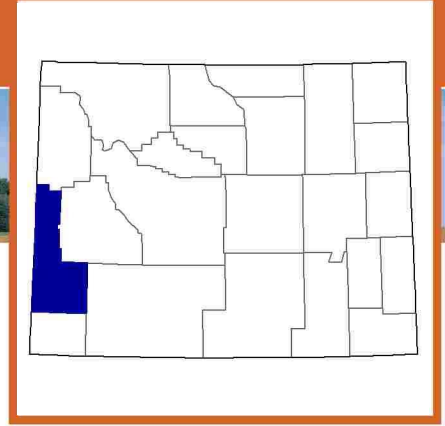

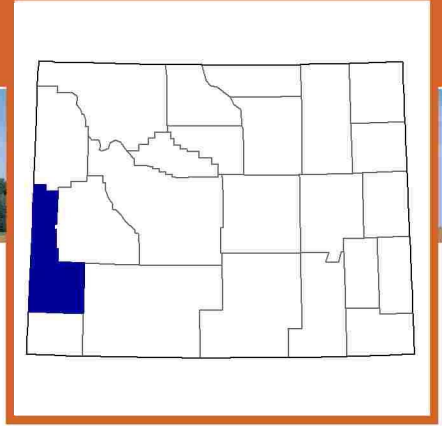
## Lincoln County, Wyoming Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

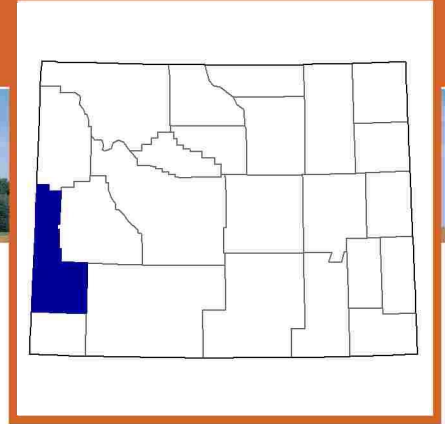
