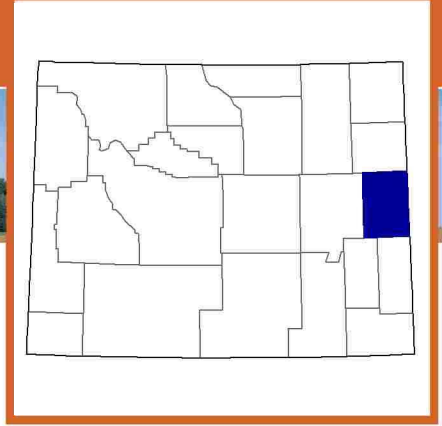


## Niobrara County, Wyoming Farms with American Indian or Alaska Native Producers<sup>a</sup>

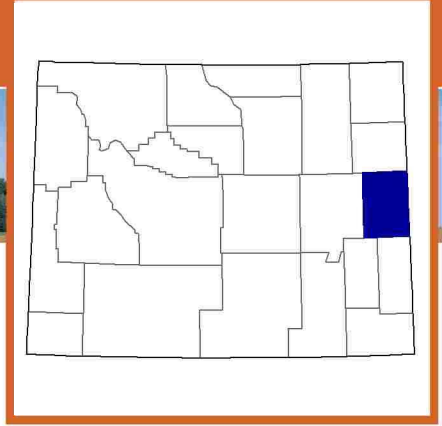


## Niobrara County, Wyoming Farms with Asian Producers<sup>a</sup>

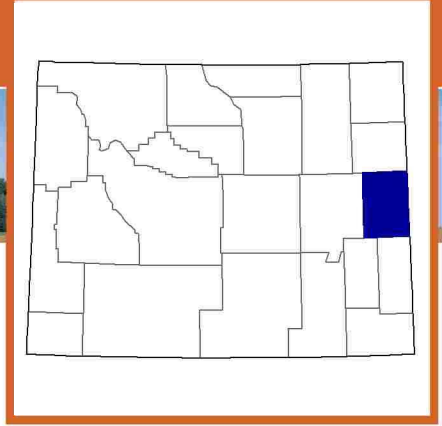


## Niobrara County, Wyoming Farms with Black or African American Producers<sup>a</sup>

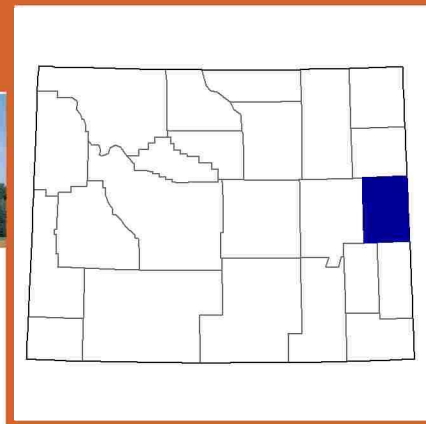

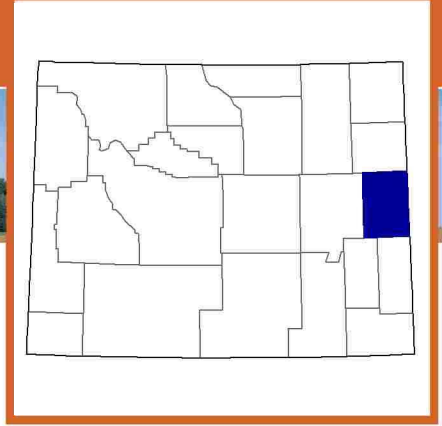

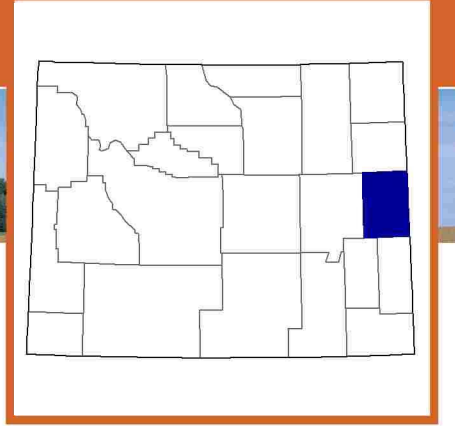
