CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING SEPTEMBER 20, 2015

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: Alfalfa conditions were mostly good to excellent, depending on location. Harvesting occurred on almost three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. Cotton harvest is at 10 percent harvested. Rangeland conditions varied widely, depending on location. Central Arizona growers had no produce movement last week. Western Arizona growers shipped mixed and miscellaneous melons last week. Rains from last week did not produce enough moisture. Some parts of the State are very dry and without sufficient forage. Seventeen of the weather stations reported receiving no precipitation this week. Canyon De Chelly has the highest year to date precipitation at 191 percent of normal, while Paloma has the lowest year to date precipitation at 44 percent of normal.
