## CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION MONTH OF FEBRUARY 2019

**AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY:** By the end of the month, cotton planting was 2 percent complete compared to 2 percent last year. Fifty-five percent of barley has been planted compared with 85 percent last year, and 41 percent has emerged compared with 71 percent last year. Barley conditions were rated mostly good. Sixty-six percent of durum wheat has been planted compared with 80 percent last year and 42 percent has emerged compared with 67 percent last year. Durum wheat conditions were rated mostly good. Alfalfa conditions were rated mostly good to fair, depending on location last week with harvesting taking place on almost three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. For the entire State, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly fair to poor. In the Northeastern and East Central part of the State, soil and pasture conditions seem to be improving with some significant snowfall received throughout the county last week. In the South Central part of the State, significant rain and snow was received by the end of the week.
