CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION WEEK ENDING APRIL 7, 2019

AGRICULTURAL SUMMARY: By the end of the week, cotton planting was 29 percent complete and 5 percent has emerged, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Ninety-eight percent of barley has emerged, and 56 percent has headed compared with 49 percent last year. Barley conditions were rated mostly good. Forty-three percent of Durum wheat has headed, the same percentage reported last year. Durum wheat conditions were rated mostly good. Alfalfa conditions were rated mostly good to fair, depending on location last week with harvesting taking place on more than three-quarters of the alfalfa acreage across the State. For the entire State, pasture and range conditions were rated mostly good to fair. In the North Central part of the State, new forage growth is beginning, but more precipitation will be needed to sustain any significant forage production. Significant amounts of forage are growing in the Northwestern part of the State, but Spring winds are already depleting soil moisture. In the Southwestern part of the State there is some green up in perennial grasses at the plant bases.
