**Week Ending: September 6, 2020**

**Released: September 8, 2020**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 3.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, September 6, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 12 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 38 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 10 percent short, 62 percent adequate, and 25 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 63.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 74.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Portland. Highs ranged from 77.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 93.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the west central part of the State with an average of 8.62 inches.
